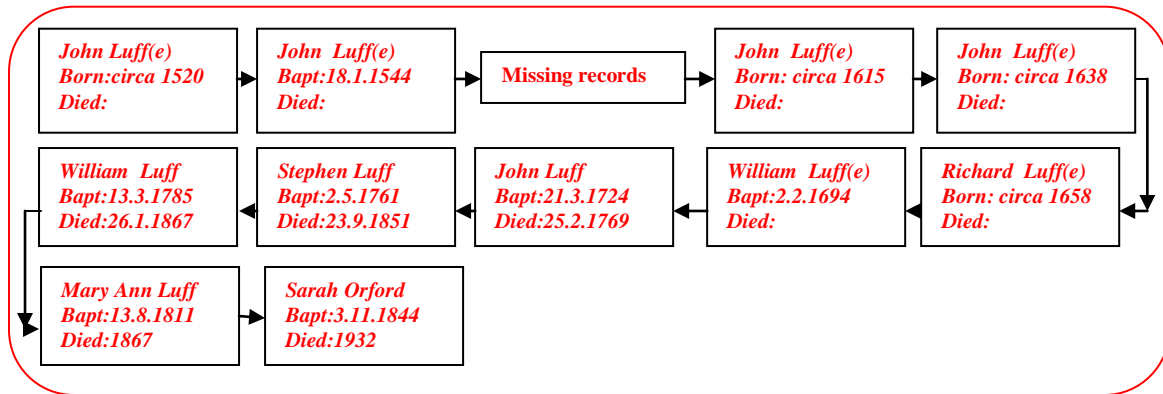
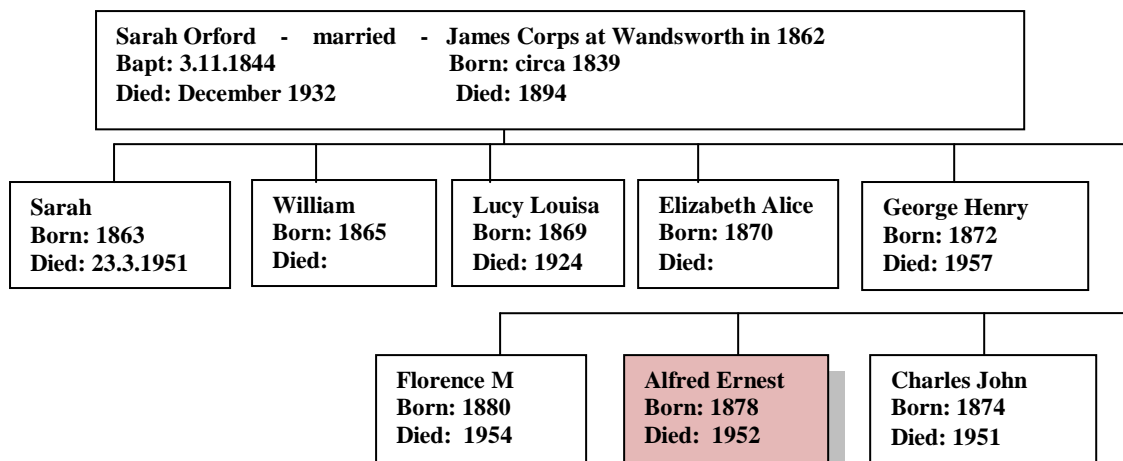


Alfred Ernest Corps 1878 - 1952
