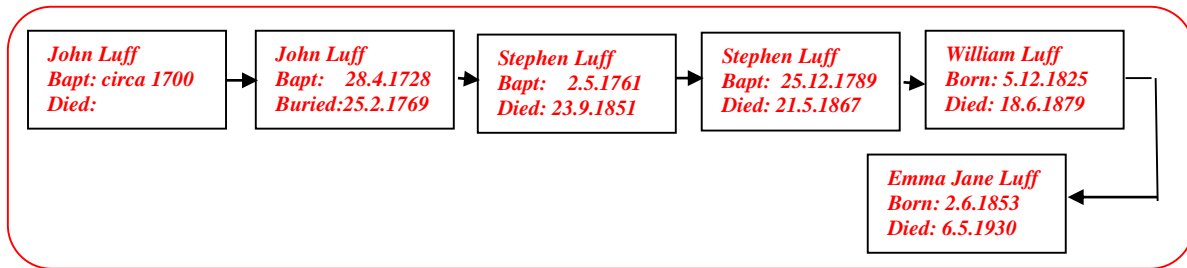


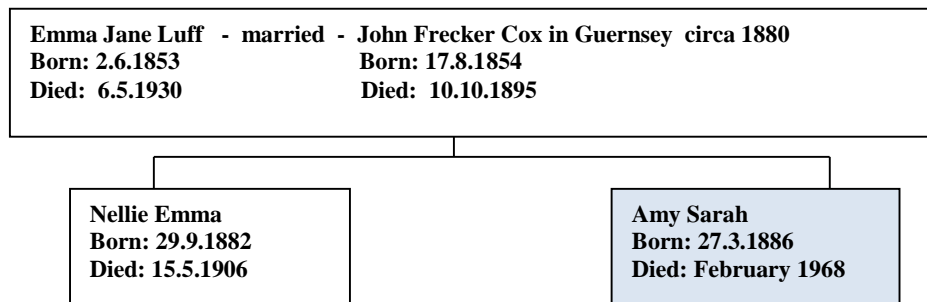
**Amy Sarah Cox 1886 - 1968**
