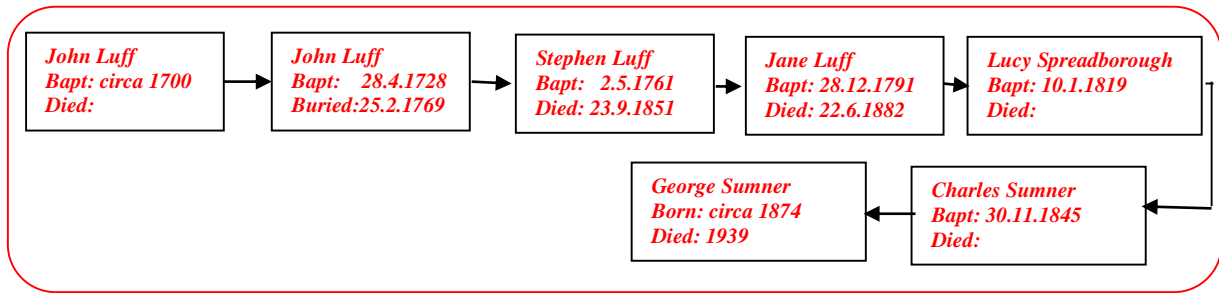


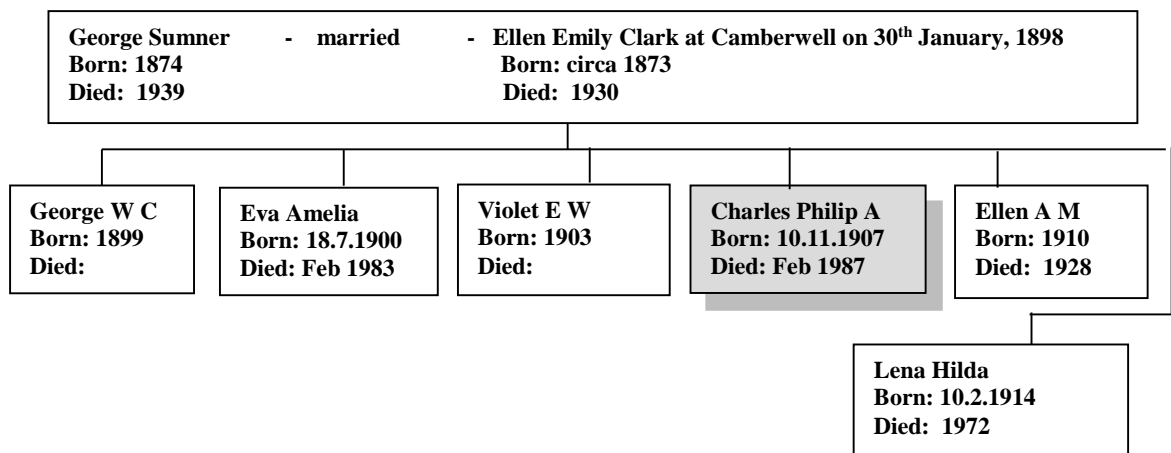

From 1936 to 1938 the family were living at 223, Guinness Buildings, Bermondsey.

In 1939 the family were living at 229, Guinness Buildings.

In 1951 the family were living at 65 Guinees Buildings.

From 1953 to 1963 the family were living at 153, Guinness Buildings.

Charles' wife, Kathleen, died in Lambeth District in March 1970

Charles died in Bexley, Kent in February, 1987.
