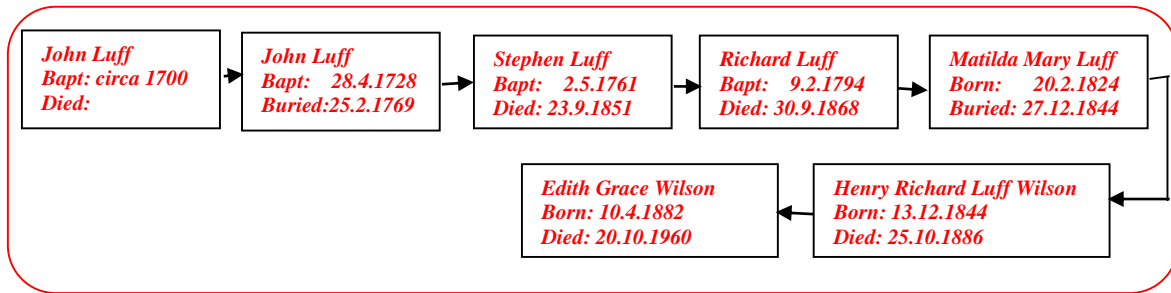

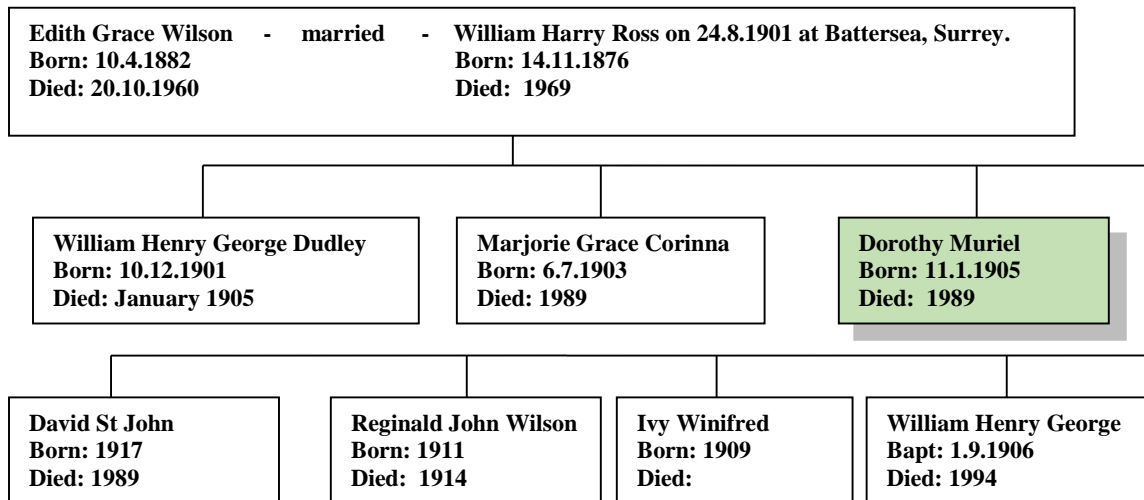
Family Lineage:

Dorothy never married and the Electoral Register for 1947 shows that she was living at 31, St Johns Hill Grove, and entitled to vote, along with her sisters Marjorie and Ivy, both single, and her brother William Henry George. The 1955 Electoral Register shows Dorothy now living at 20, Cyril Mansions, North Battersea.

Dorothy died in the District of Merton in 1989.
