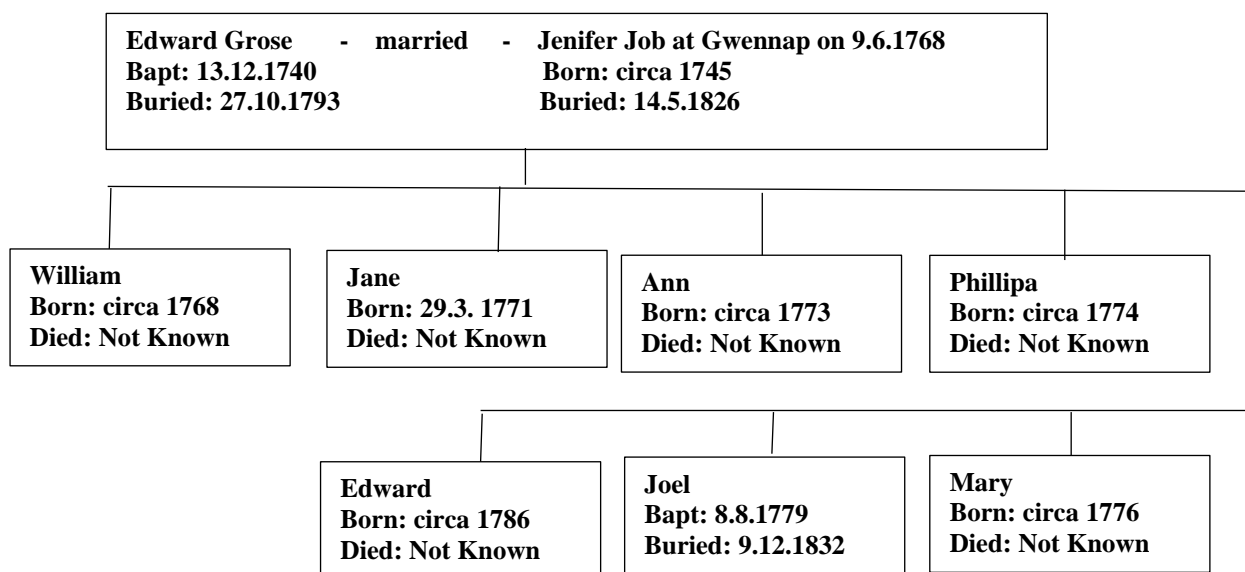
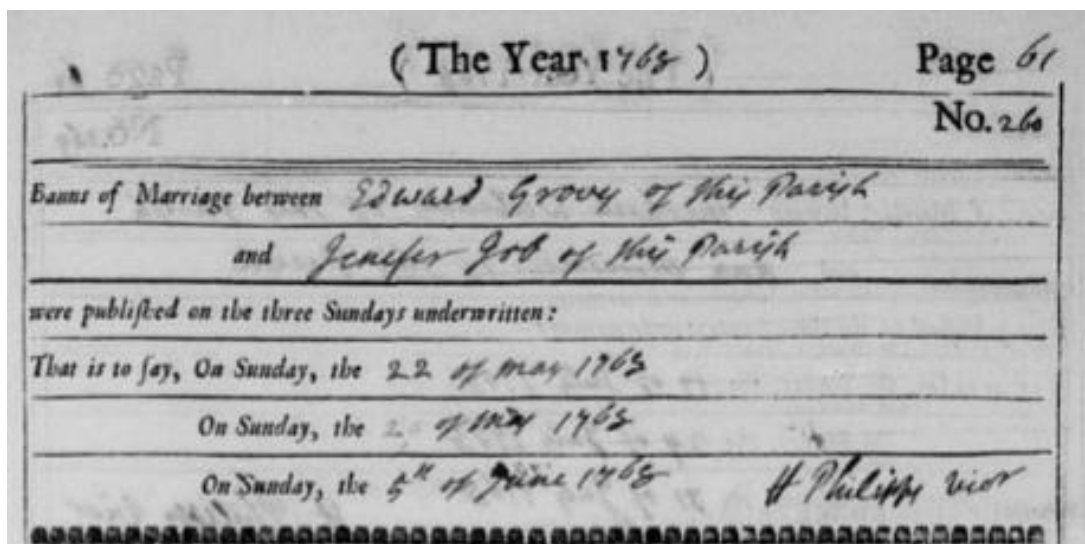
Edward Grose was baptized at Kenwyn, Cornwall on 13.12.1740. He is the son of Edward and Elizabeth Grose.

Jenifer (aka) Jane Job is the aunty of Zephaniah Job (1740 – 1822) who was known as the ‘Smuggler’s Banker’. Zephaniah evaded being prosecuted for smuggling, but it seems he dealt with the profits and distributed much to the widow’s and children of the smugglers who were hanged or imprisoned.
