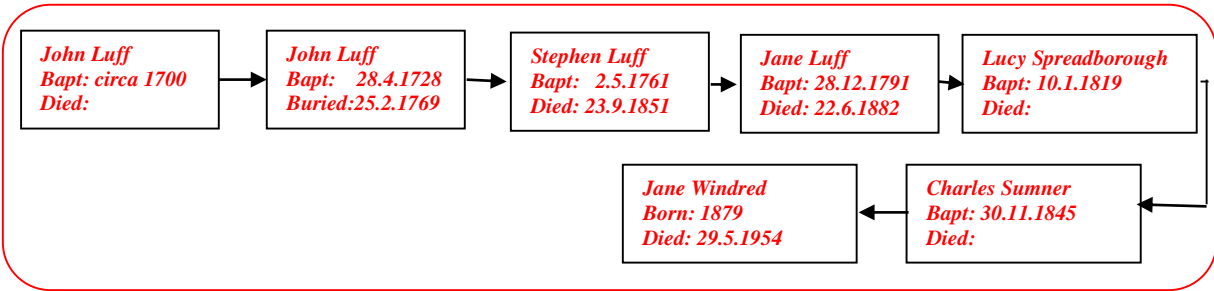

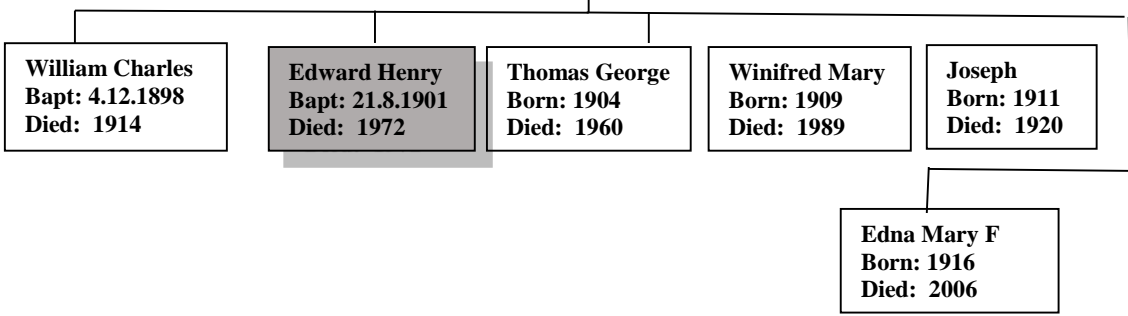

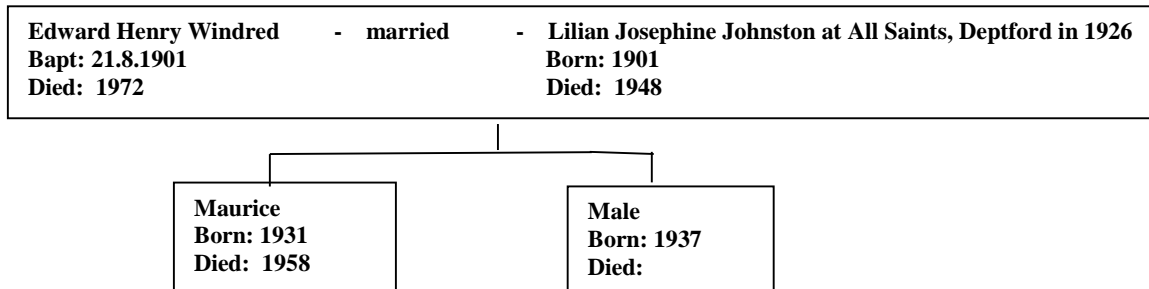

The Electoral Register shows that from 1923 to 1929, Edward Henry Windred (jnr), lived with his parents at 68, Kender Street, Deptford, his wife Lilian also lived at the address from 1926 to 1929.

Edward Henry Windred married Lilian Josephine Johnston at All Saints, Deptford, in 1926.



The Electoral Register shows Edward and Lilian had various accommodations from 1929 until Lilian's death in 1948:

1929 – 1930 - 4, Batavia Road Deptford.

1931 – 1932 - 5, Jephson Street, Camberwell

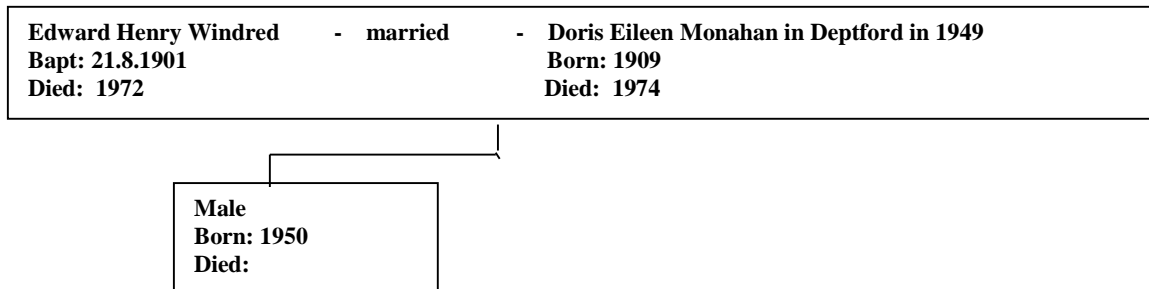
1932 - 95, Fernbrook Street, Lewisham

1932 – 1937 - 412, New Cross, Deptford, living with Edward's parents.

1938 – 1948 – 18, Mornington Road, Deptford.

Edward's wife, Lilian, died in 1948.

Edward Henry Windred remarried, his new wife was Doris Eileen Monahan, in Deptford in 1949



The Electoral Register shows that Edward and Doris lived at 9, Besson Street, Deptford, from the time of their marriage in 1949 to 1965 (latest year available to me).

Edward Henry Windred died in 1972

Doris Eileen Monahan died in 1974.
