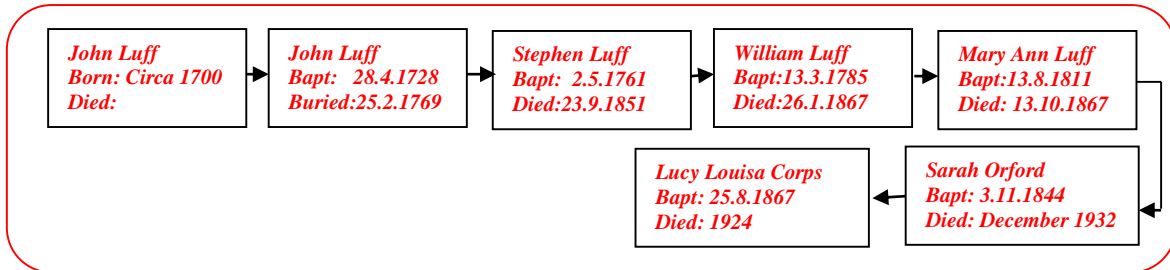
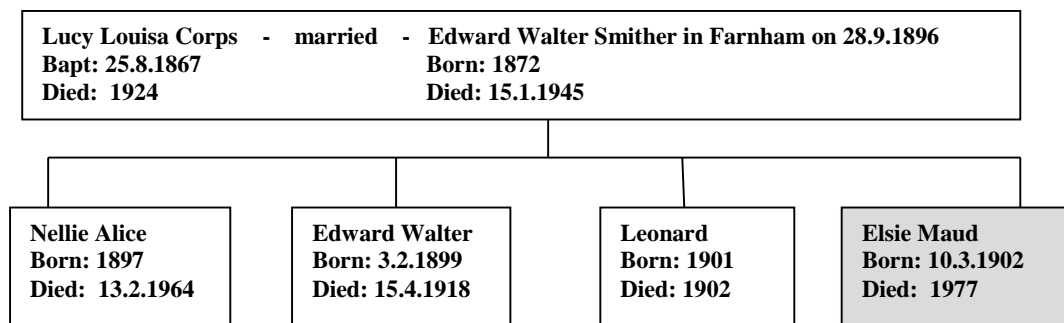


**Family Lineage:**

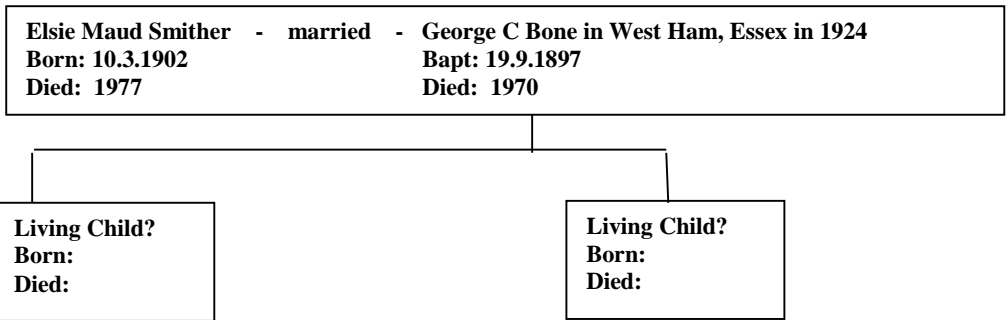
