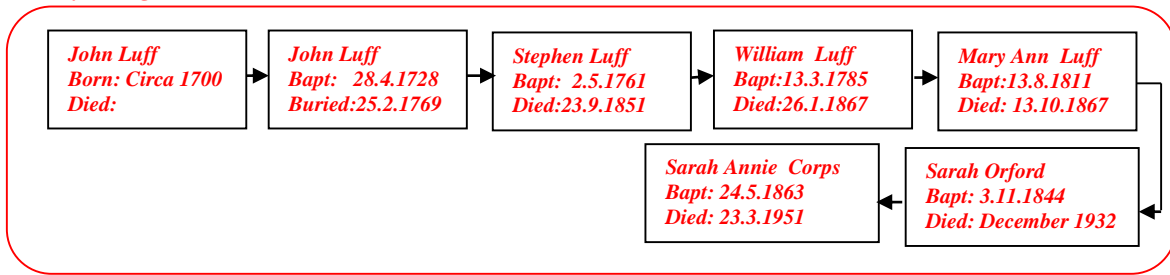
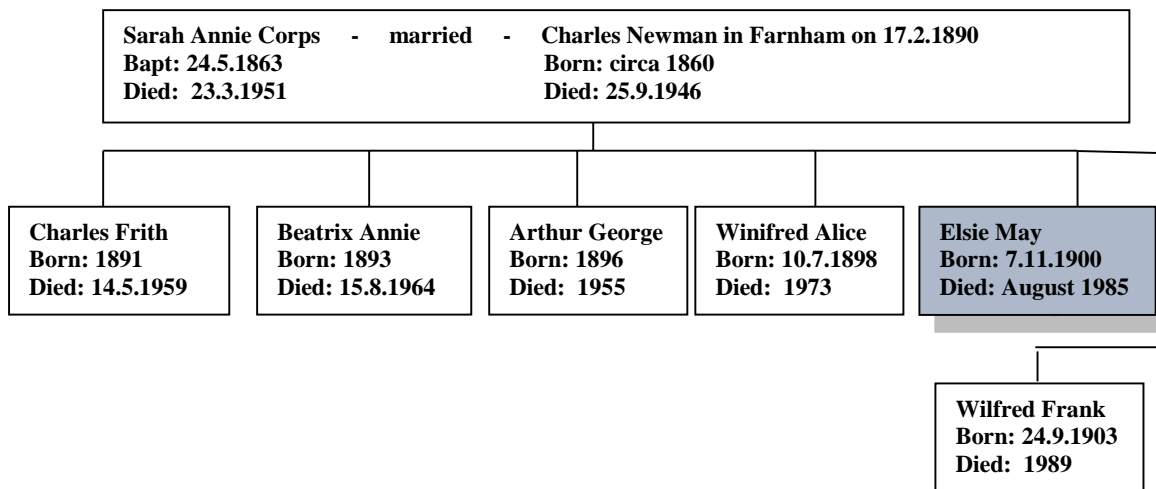


Family Lineage:
