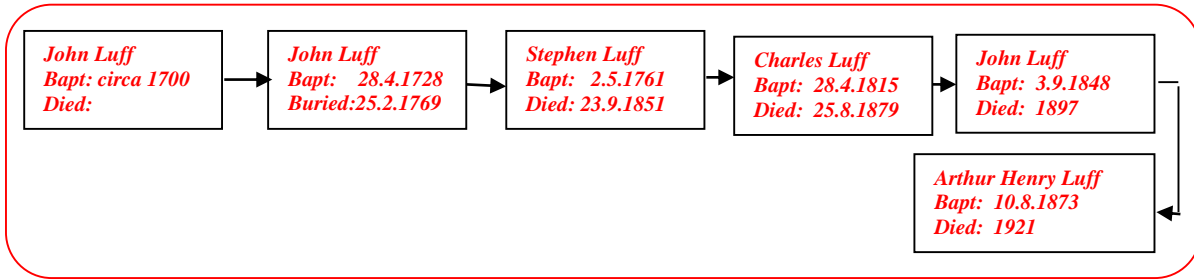


Emily Matilda (Dorothy) Redwood Luff 1897 - 1976
