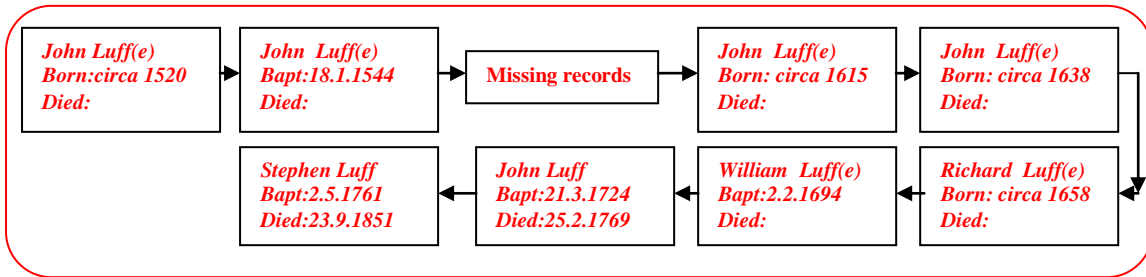
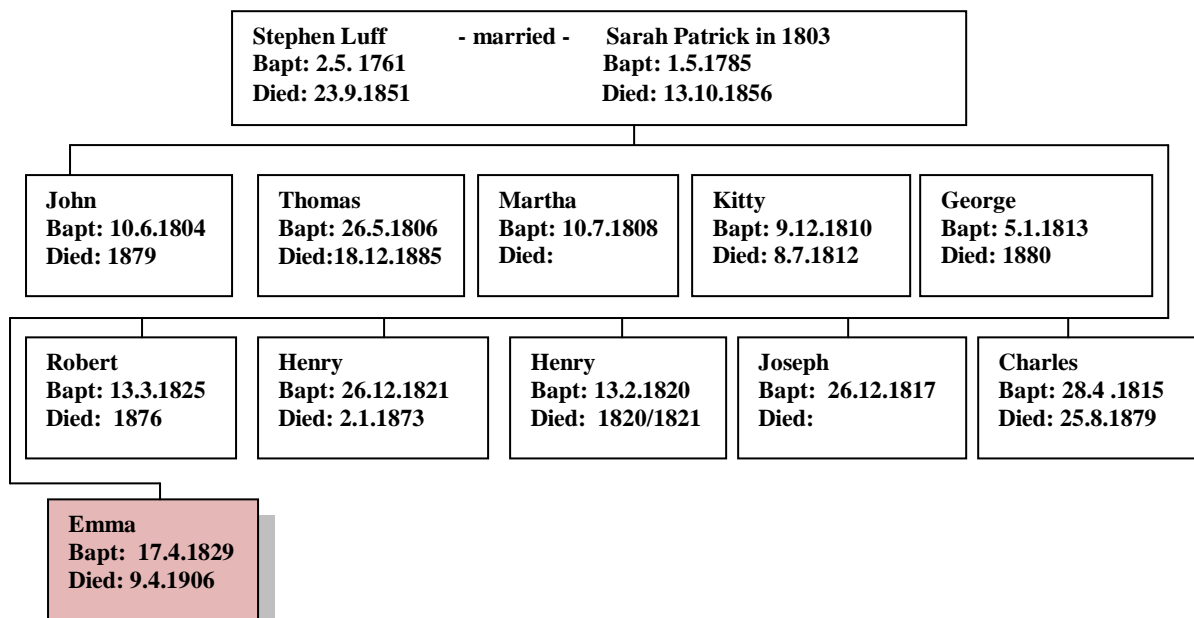


## Emma Luff 1829 - 1906

### Family Lineage:



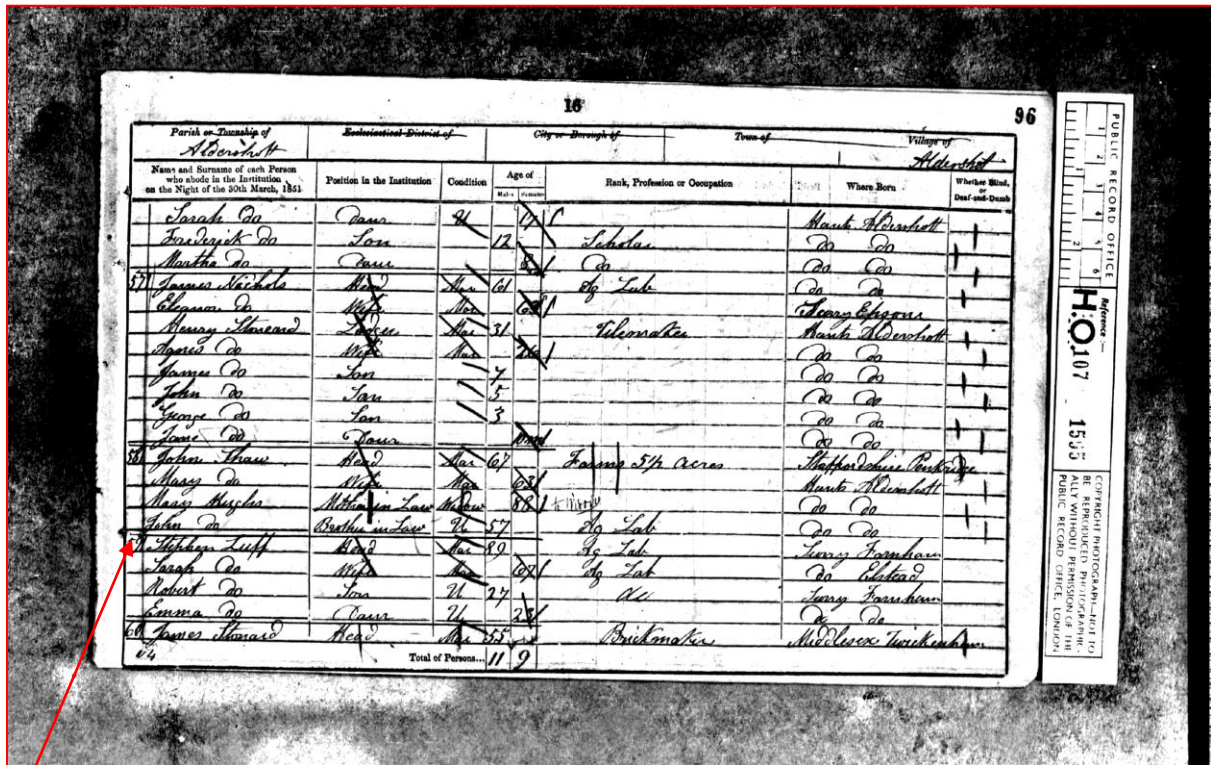

The 1881 Census shows Emma, stating her age as 42 and single, and lodging at 7 Pharo Row, Upper Hale, Farnham. It is more likely her age was 52. Emma was lodging with Charlotte Young and her brother. For the first time Emma is recorded as being an imbecile from childhood.

The 1901 Census shows Emma, stating her age now as 77 and single, and an inmate in the Union Workhouse, Farnham. Emma died in the Union Workhouse in 1906, her age at death was 78 so she would have been 72 in 1901.
