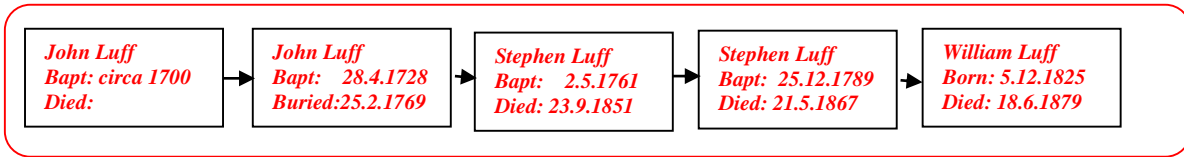


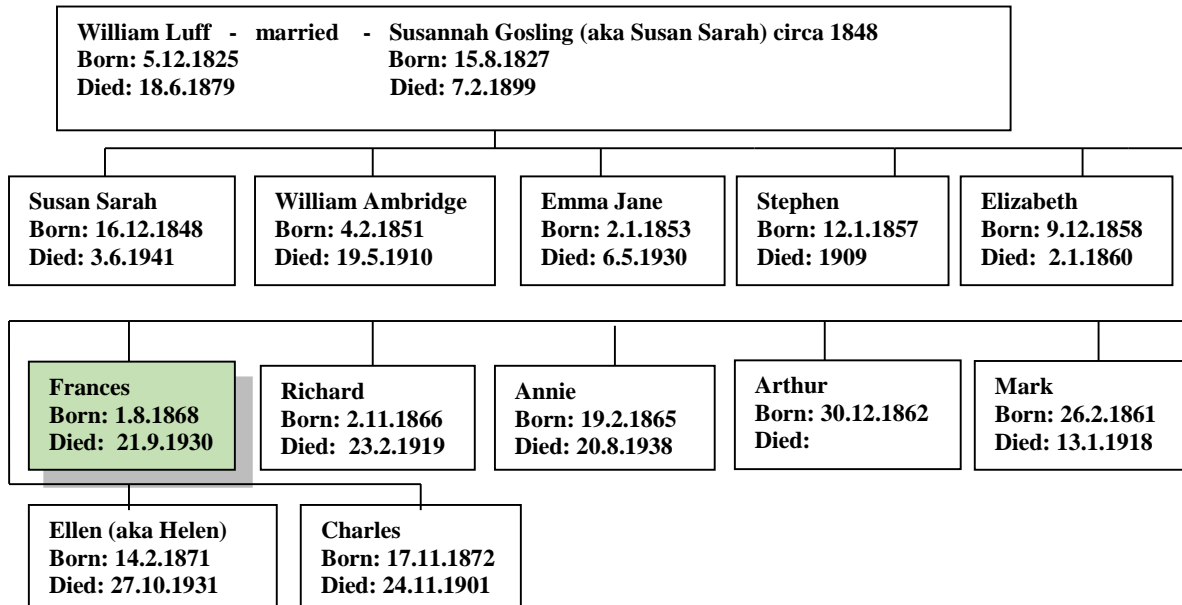
**Frances Luff 1868 - 1930**

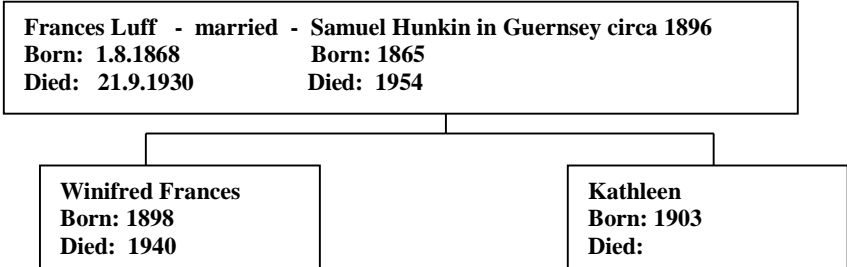

Extract from the Will/Probate for Frances Hunkin.

**HUNKIN Frances** of 80 Belle Vue-road Southbourne Hampshire (wife of Samuel Hunkin) died 21 September 1930 Probate London 11 December to the said Samuel Hunkin retired draper. Effects £755.

Samuel died in Hampshire in 1954.
