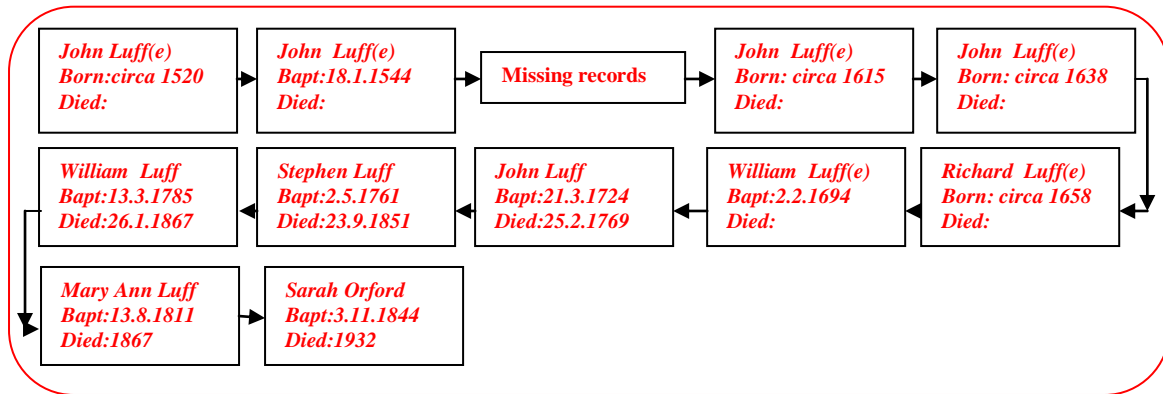
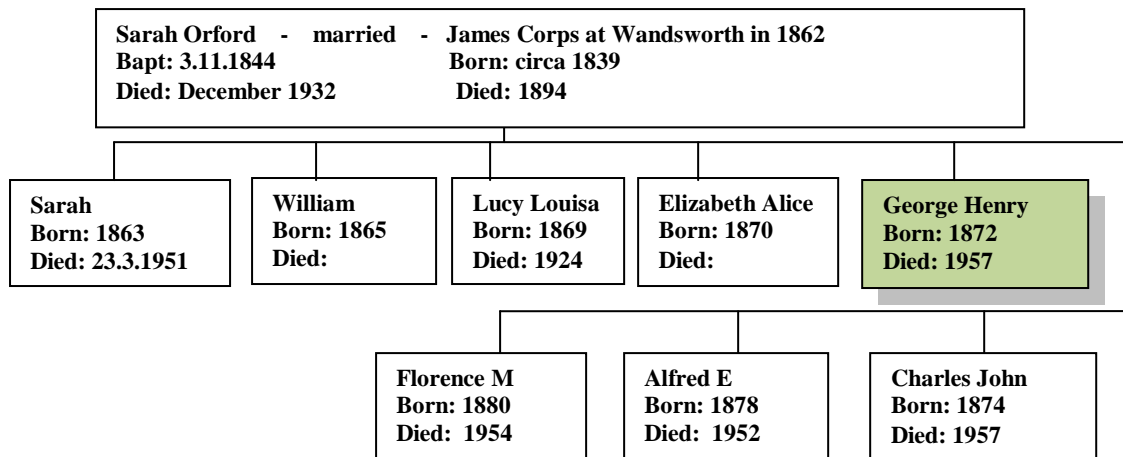


George Henry Corps 1872 - 1957

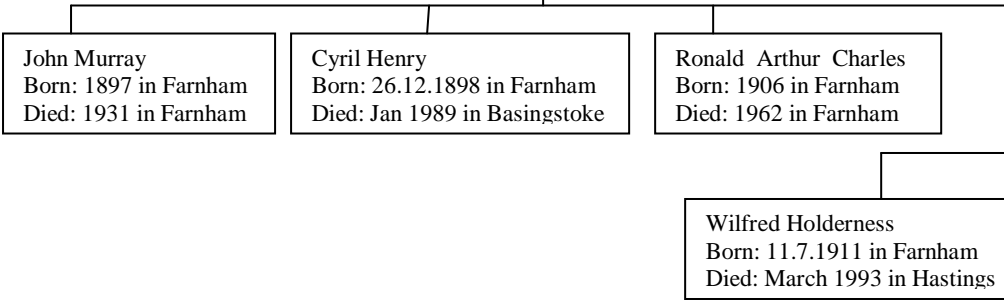
