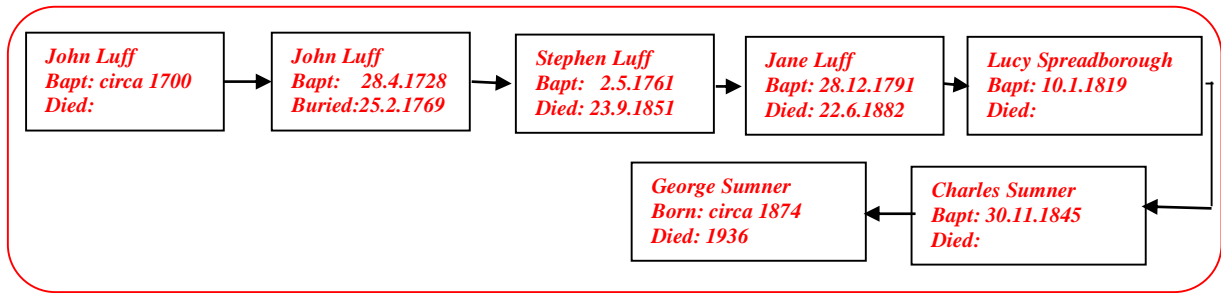


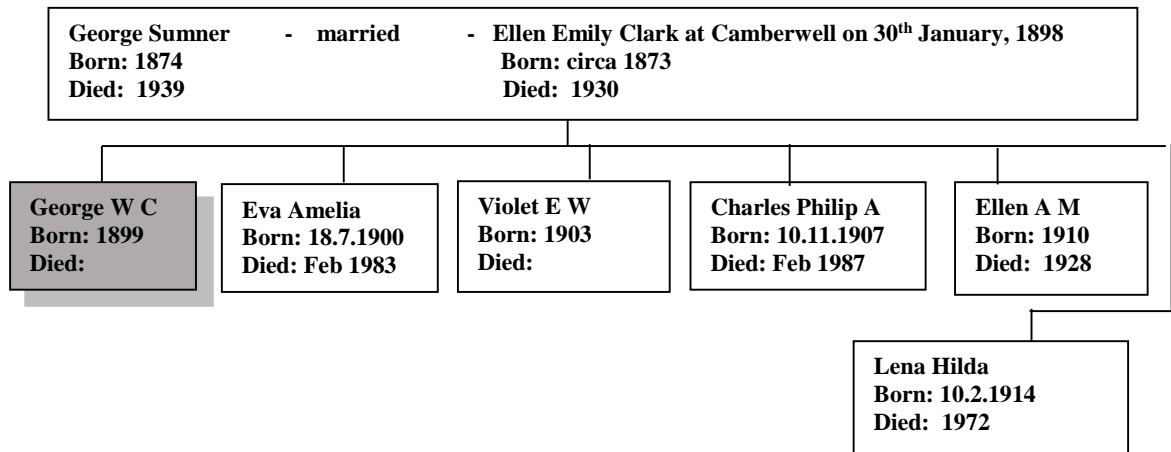
**George William Charles Sumner 1899 -**

George William Charles Sumner married Annie Violet Knight in 1932 at Camberwell, Surrey.

They lived at 17, Chadwick Road, Peckham from 1933 to 1939.
