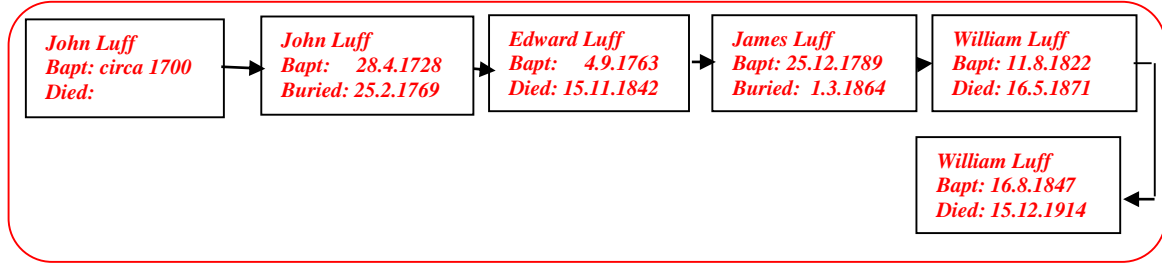

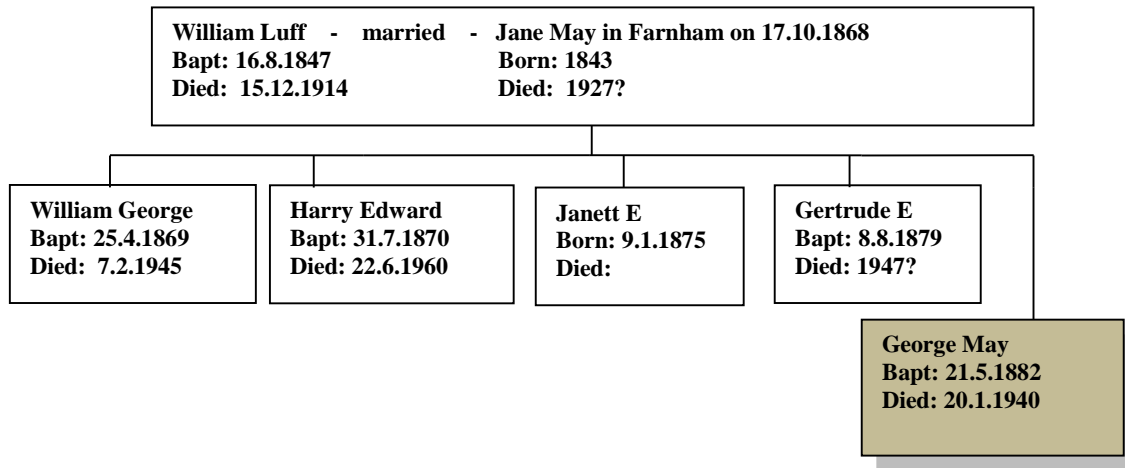
George May Luff was baptized on 21st May, 1882 in Hounslow. He was a son of William and Jane Luff.

George May Luff married Ethel Thacker on 3rd October, 1918 in Hounslow.

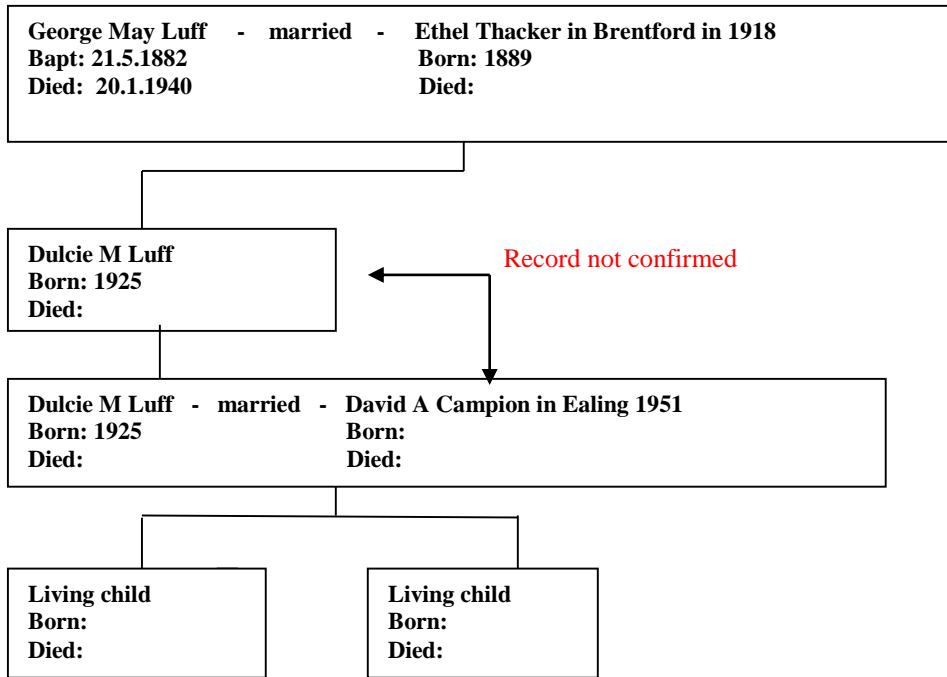

From 1928 to 1940 George May and his wife Ethel were living at 81, Wood Lane, Isleworth.

George May Luff died on 20th January 1940 at the Hotel Metropole Bournemouth.
