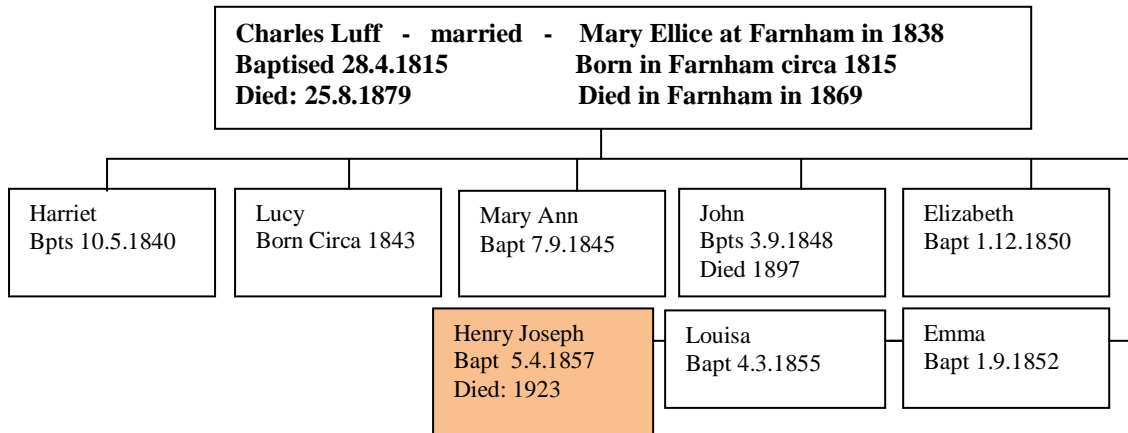


Henry Joseph Luff 1857 - 1923

Henry Joseph Luff was born in Farnham and baptised in Aldershot on 5th April, 1857. He was the son of Charles and Mary Luff.



The 1871 census shows Henry living with his father in No Wives Lane, Hale. He was 14 years old and employed as an agricultural labourer.

In 1881 Henry was living in Hoghatch Lane, Upper Hale, his father having died in 1879. He was single, aged 24 and still employed as an agricultural labourer.

In 1883 Henry married Annie Warner in Farnham. Annie Warner was born in Farnham circa 1860.

The 1891 shows Henry and Annie living at Florence Cottage, Cuckfield, Sussex. Henry was employed as a carman.

On the 1901 census it records that Henry and Annie were living back in Hale, Henry was employed as a general labourer. Also recorded was that they had a child, Fanny who was born in Farnham in 1897. Henry was then 44 and Annie 41 years of age. However on the 1911 census, the couple state that they had never had any children? The couple were living in Providence Cottages, Upper Hale. Henry was employed as a carman for a builder.

Henry Joseph Luff died in Farnham in 1923.
