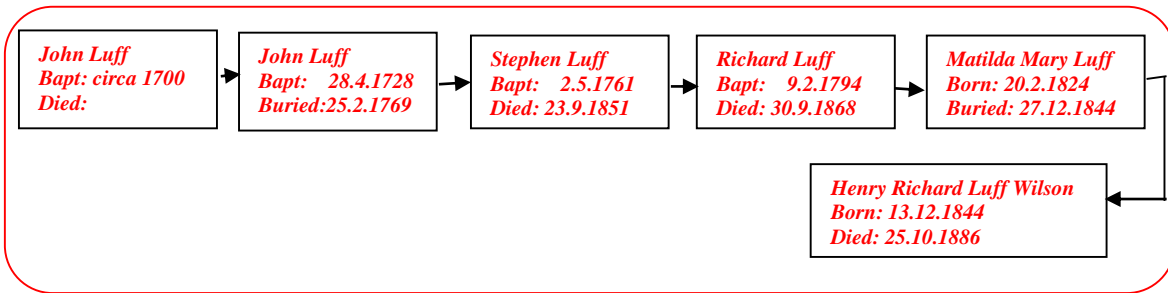

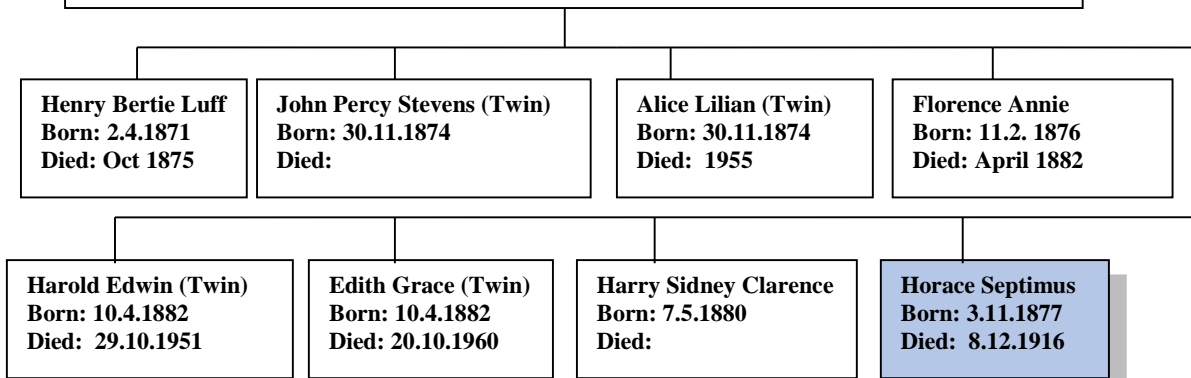

Horace Septimus Wilson joined the 21st (County of London) Battalion (1st Surrey Rifles) at the outbreak of World War 1, as a rifleman. He died on 8th December, 1916 from his wounds.

WILSON Horace Septimus of 9 Montreal-road Ilford Essex private 21st London regiment died 8 December 1916 at Military Hospital Easton Winchester Administration London 15 March to Maude Wilson widow. Effects £245 11s. 5d.

Horace's widow, Maude continued to live in Essex, and died on 25th September, 1962.
