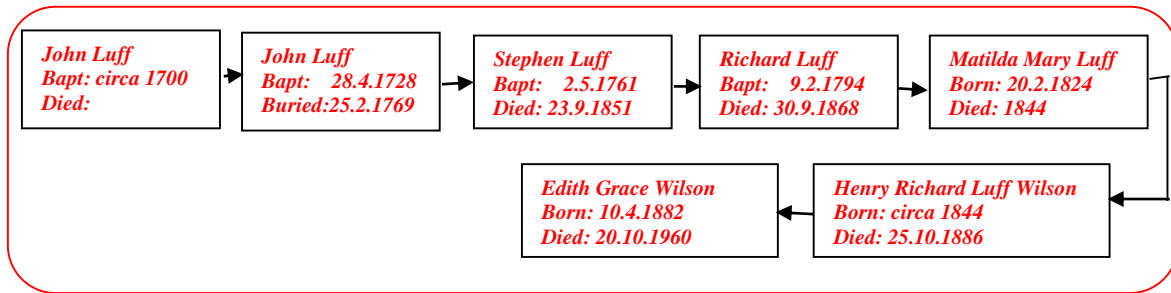


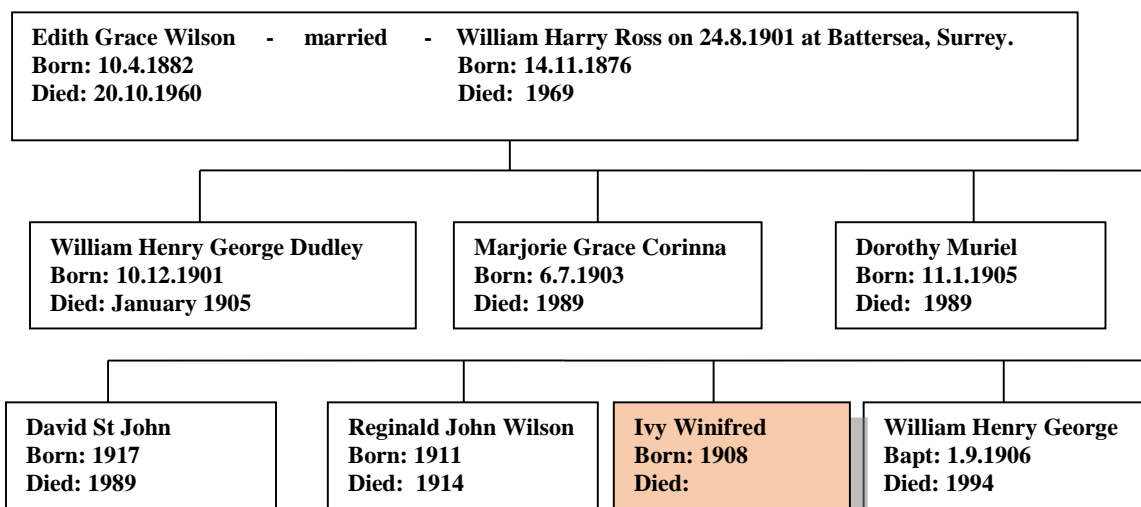

In 1918 Ivy moved with her family to 31, St Johns Hill Grove, Battersea. This was the family home until 1960 when her mother, Edith, died and 1969 when her father William died.
