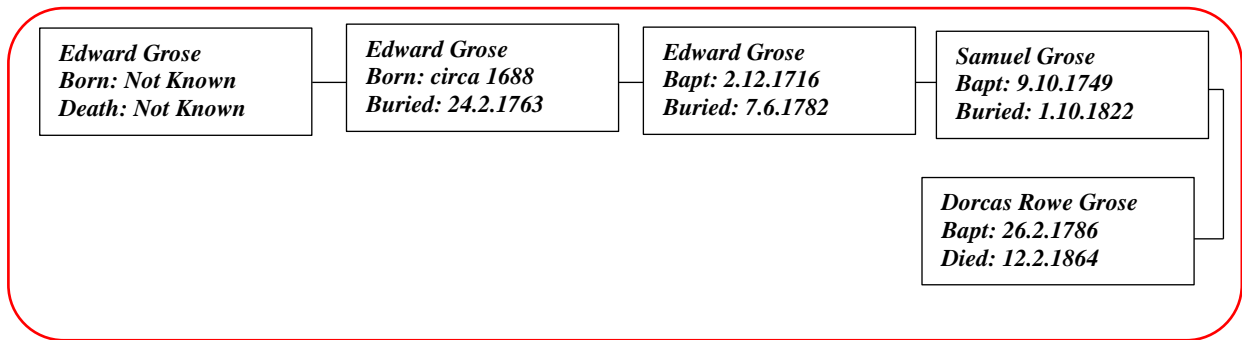

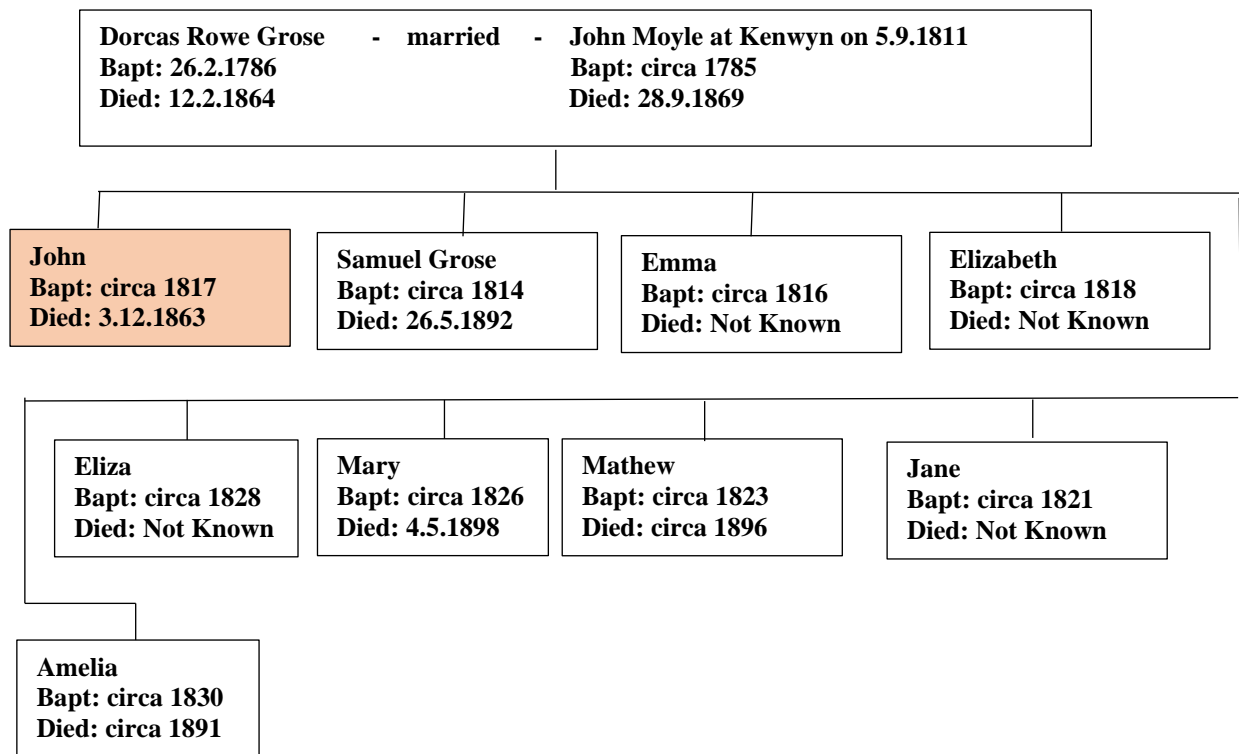

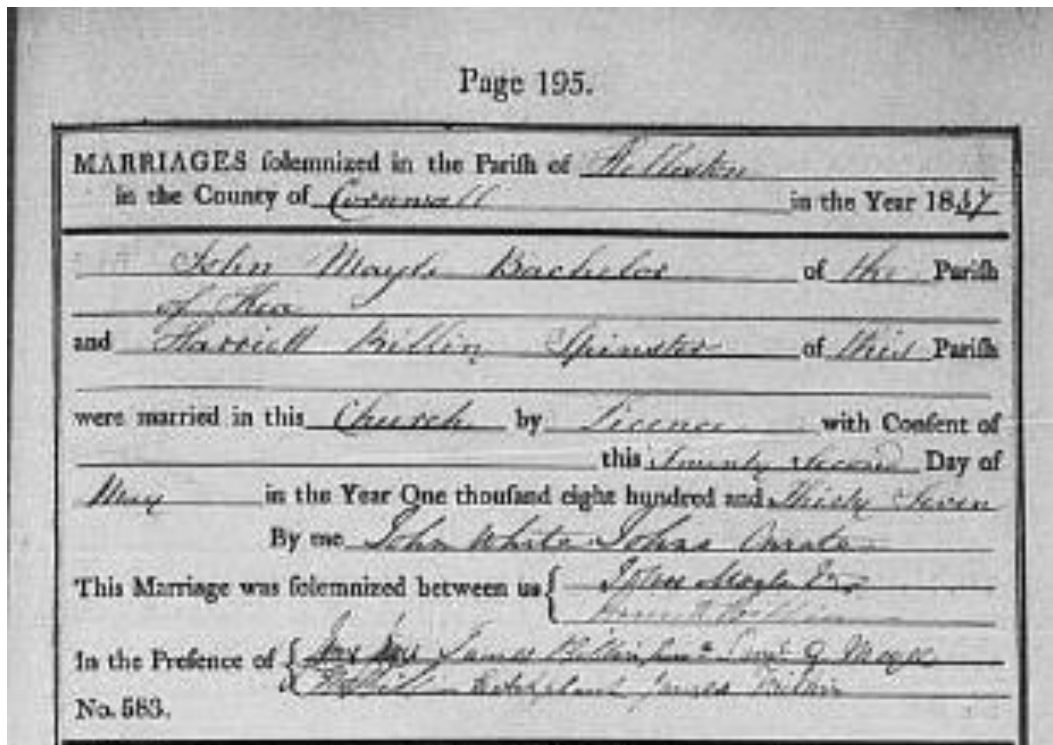


John Moyle was born circa 1812 at Gwennap. Cornwall He is the son of Dorcas and John Moyle.

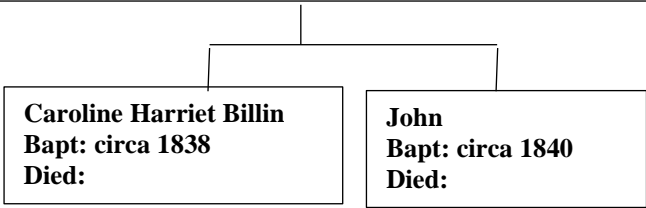
