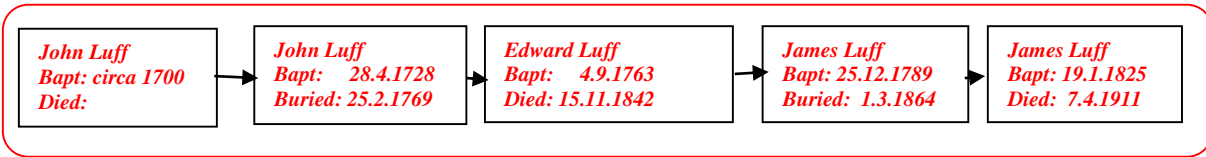

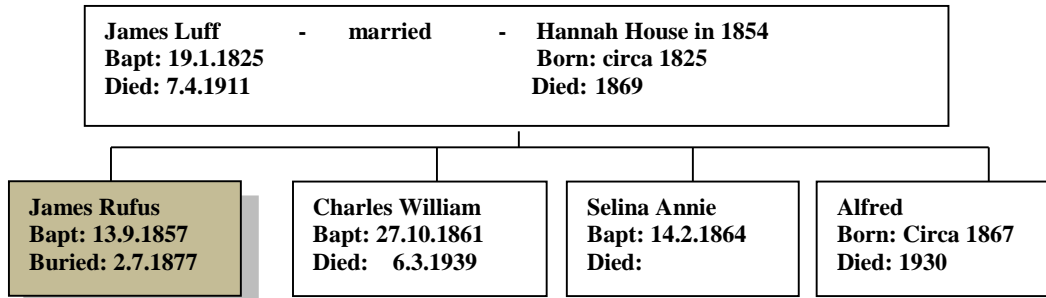


James Rufus Luff was baptised in Tottenham, Middlesex on 13th September, 1857. He is the son of James and Hannah Luff.
