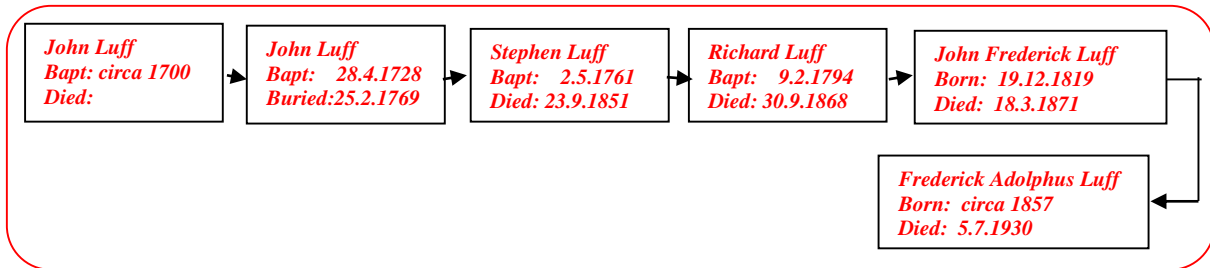


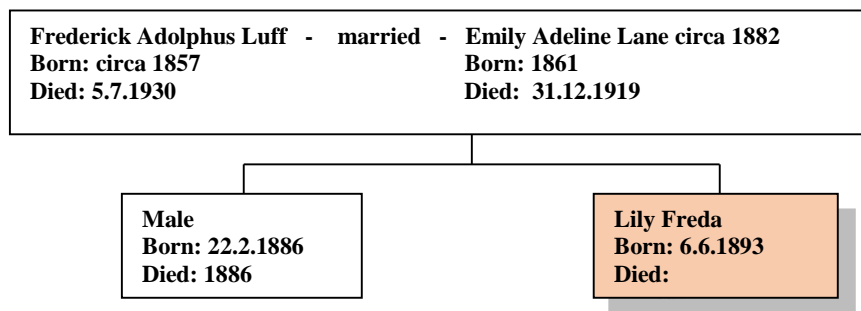

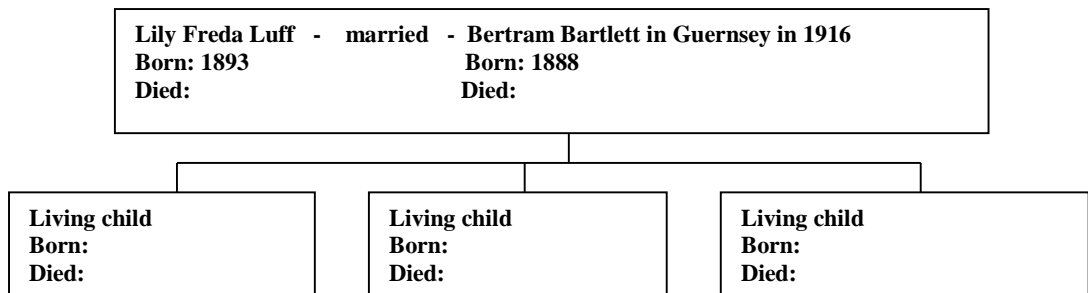

Lily Freda married Bertram Bartlett in 1916 (Source: Guernsey Family Historian). They had 3 children.

Bertram Bartlett was a prominent Rotarian. He married into the Luff family and ran the Luff grocery stores that were the forerunner of the Island Wide Stores. Christmas parcels were started soon after the Liberation and goods were supplied by Luff & Co.



Lily's mother, Emily Adeline died on 31st December, 1919

I have no further information about Lily at the present time.
