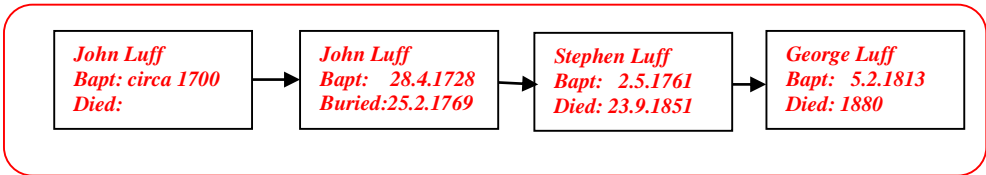


Family Lineage:



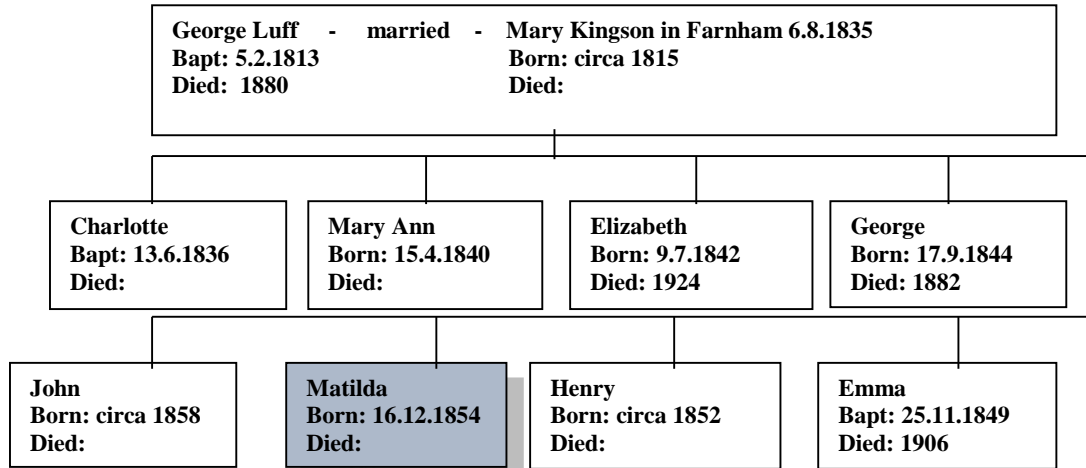
