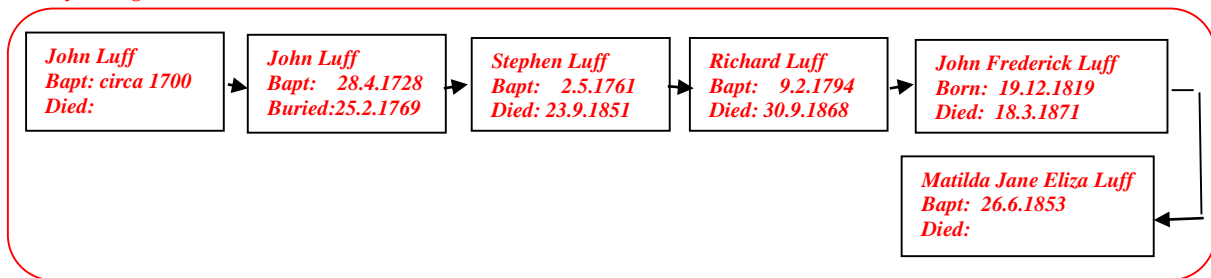


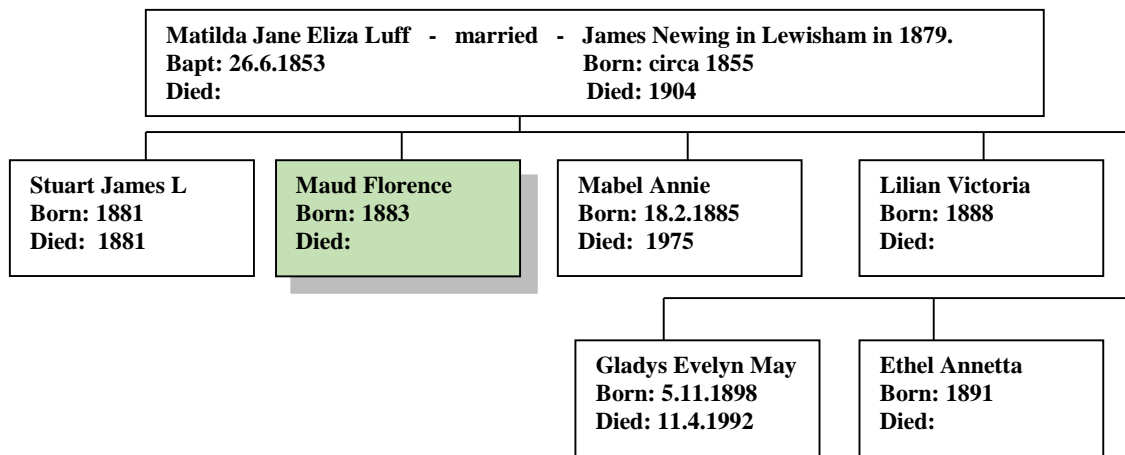

Below is a copy of the ships manifest for the SS Dominion showing the application for admission in 1905 of Maud Newing from Canada into the U.S.A. Maud gives her age as 22 years and her relation is her mother Matilda Newing in Elham, Kent England. Clearly Maud had left England probably between 1891 and 1905. Also on this passage was Maud's younger sister Lilian Victoria Newing.

At some time between arriving in the U.S.A. and the 1940 Census, Maud married George Ferguson. The 1940 Census shows Maude and her husband George living at 248W, King County, Seattle, Washington. They own the property and its value is \$1,800. George puts his age as 67 and Maude 57.
