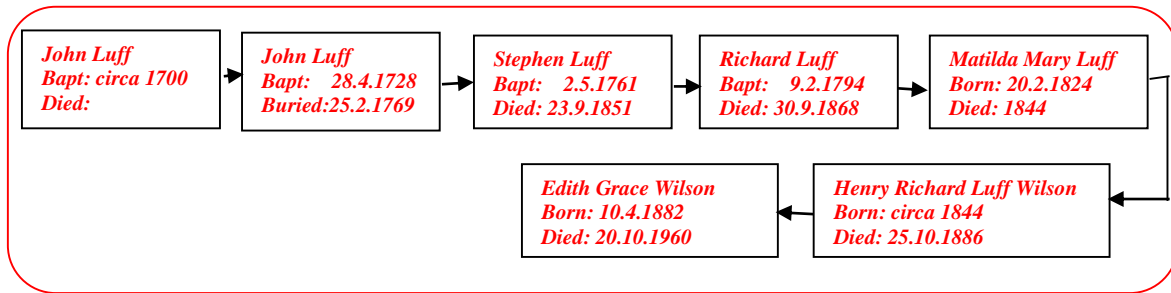


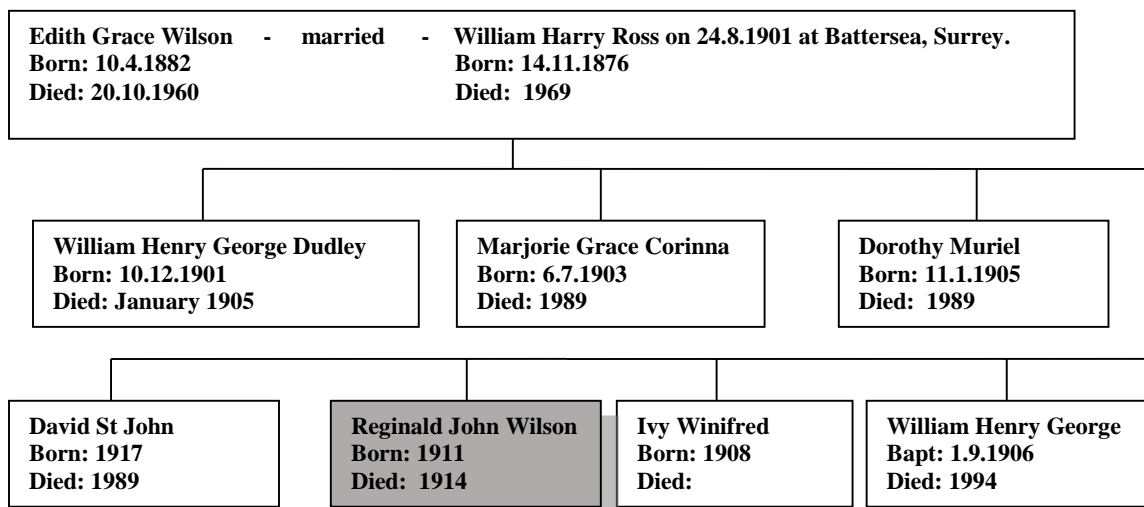
**Reginald John Wilson Ross 1911 - 1914**
