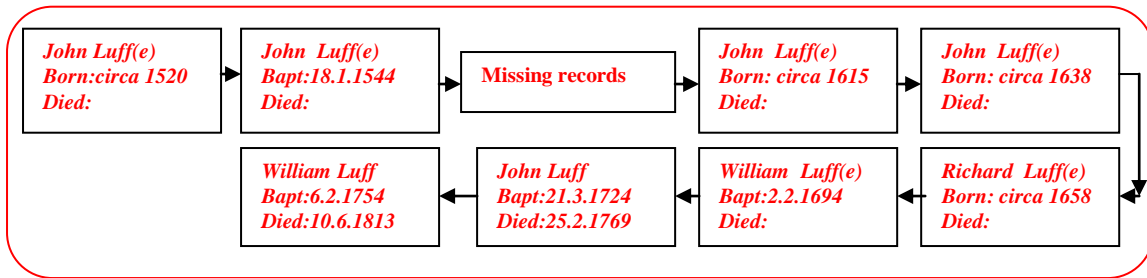


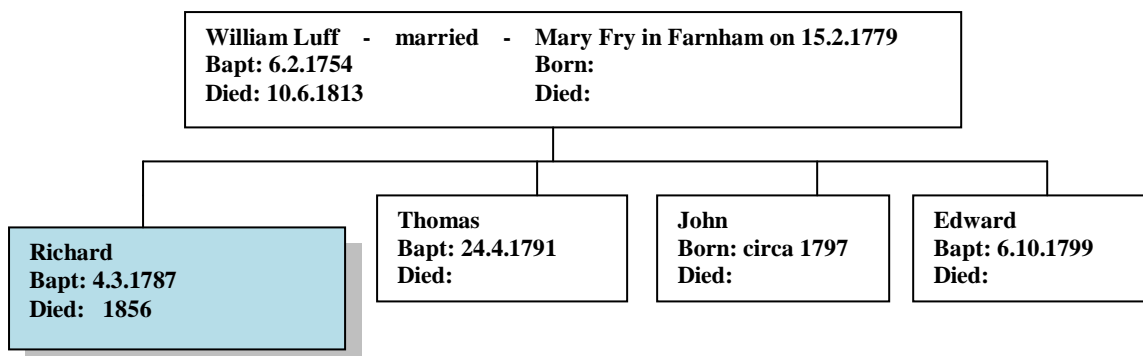
Richard Luff 1787 - 1856

Family Lineage:



Richard Luff, son of William and Mary Luff, was baptised in Haslemere Parish, Surrey, on 4th March, 1787.

In the 1841 census, Richard was shown as living in Crofs Ways, Witley, Surrey. He was a widower, aged 54 and employed as an agricultural labourer. Living at the same address were Hannah Stilwell, a widow (aged 57) and Hannah Caston (aged 70).

In the 1851 census Richard was living at the same address, he was then 64 and still employed as an agricultural labourer. Living at the same address were Hannah Stilwell, a widow (aged 67) and his younger brother Edward Luff, aged 51.
