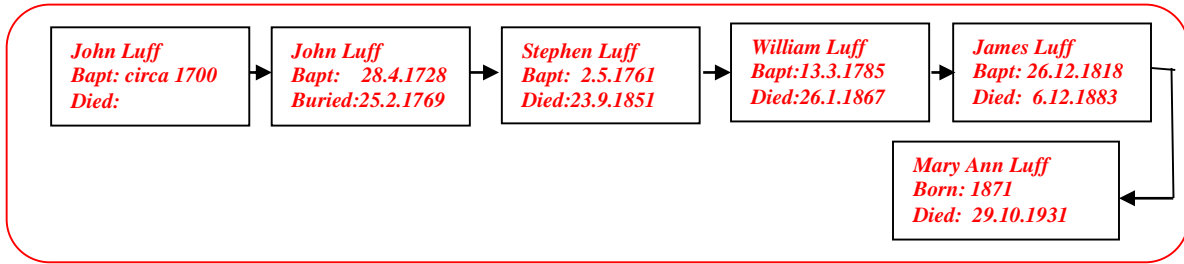
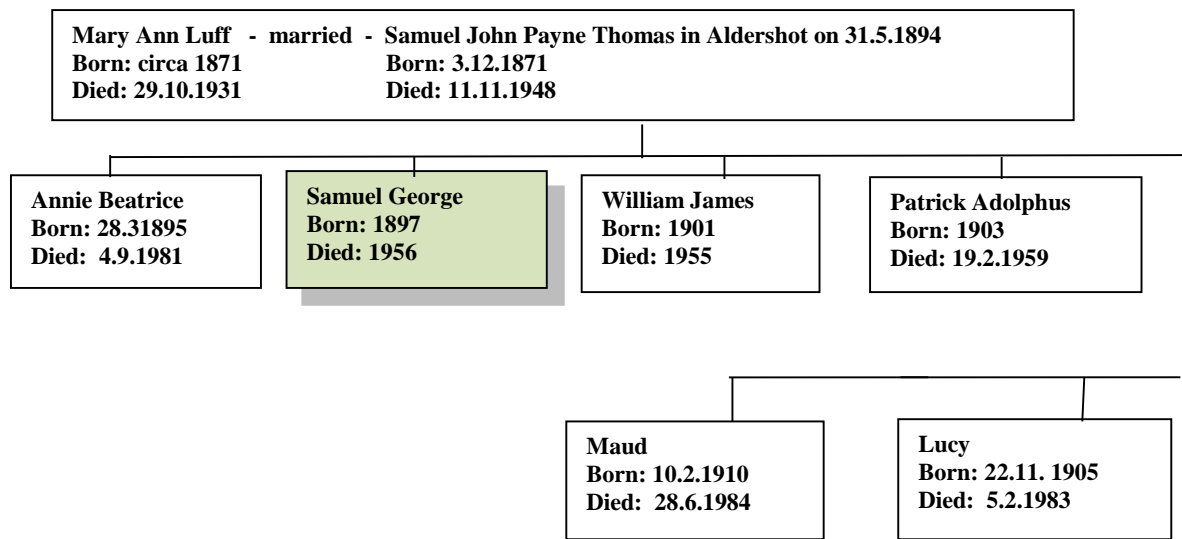


Family Lineage:

Samuel George Thomas saw action in Flanders in the 1st World War. I understand that he and William Charles Luff (his sister's future husband) actually met on the battlefield.

When Samuel return after the War, his father got him a job as a gardener in either Hyde Park or St James' Park.

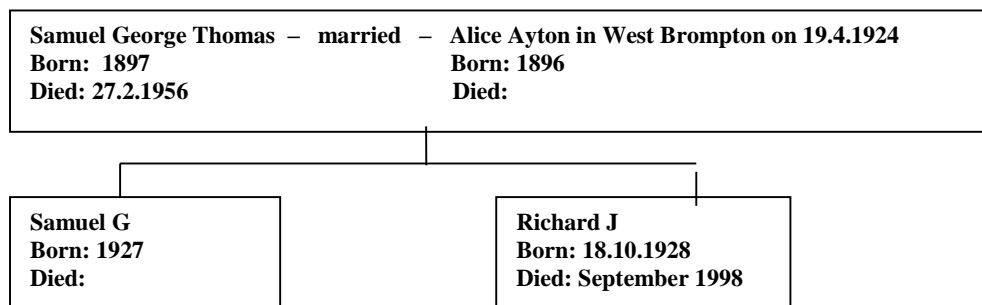

Samuel George married Alice Ayton in West Brompton on 19th April, 1924. (*Source Official Marriage Certificate*)

According to the marriage certificate Samuel's occupation was a welder.



The Electoral Registers for 1929-1939 shows Samuel George Thomas and his wife Alice Thomas living at 30, Colehill Lane, Fulham, S.W.6

The Electoral Register for 1947 shows Samuel George & Alice Thomas living at 7F, Vera Road, Fulham, S.W.6

In 1948 and 1949 the Electoral Register shows Samuel George Thomas (jnr) - Samuel & Alice's eldest son was now eligible to vote (aged 21), all 3 were living at 7F, Vera Road.

From 1950 to February 1956 the family were still living at 7F, Vera Road, also included on the Electoral Register was Richard J Thomas, the younger son of Samuel & Alice.

Samuel George Thomas died on 27th February, 1956.

From 1957 to 1961 Alice Thomas and her sons Samuel G and Richard J Thomas continued to live at 7F, Vera Road, Fulham.
