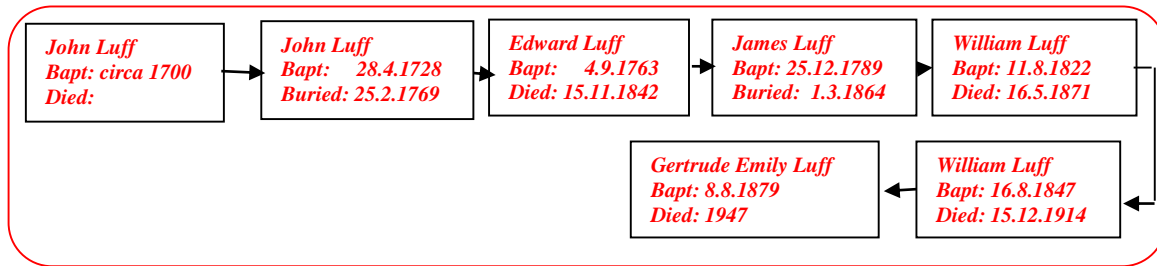


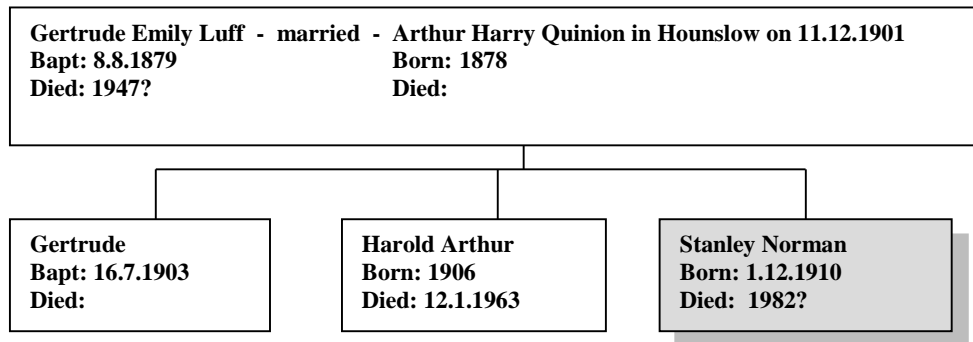
Stanley Norman Quinion 1910 - 1982

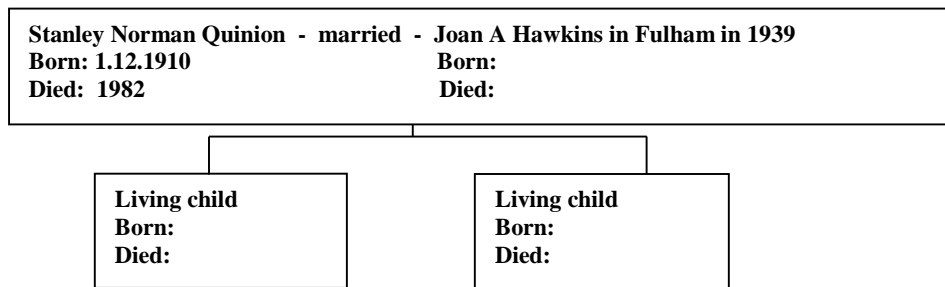

Stanley Norman Quinion - aged 4 months - Born in Willesden

In 1939 Stanley Norman was living at 9, Charleville Road, Fulham, W.14 with his brother Harold and wife Olive, and his mother Gertrude.

Stanley Norman married Joan A Hawkins in Fulham in 1939.

The Electoral Registers for the period 1947 to 1956 show that Stanley Norman and his wife Joan were living at 9, Charleville Road, Fulham, W.14.

No mention is made of Stanley's mother, who I believe died in 1947. Also his brother Harold and wife Olive are not now resident at the address.

Stanley Norman Quinion died in Chatham in 1982. **(Record not confirmed)**
