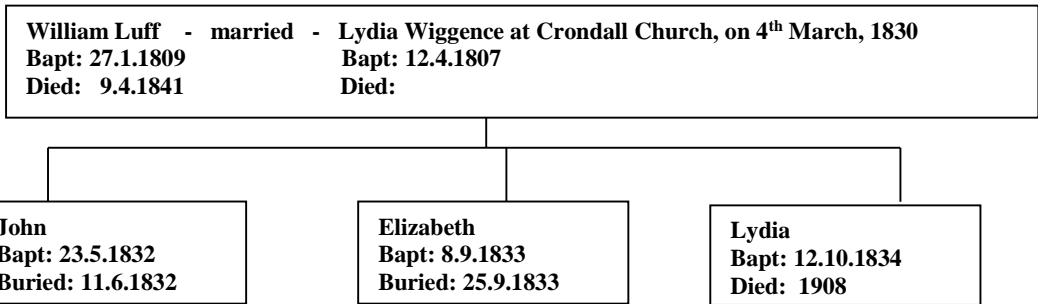
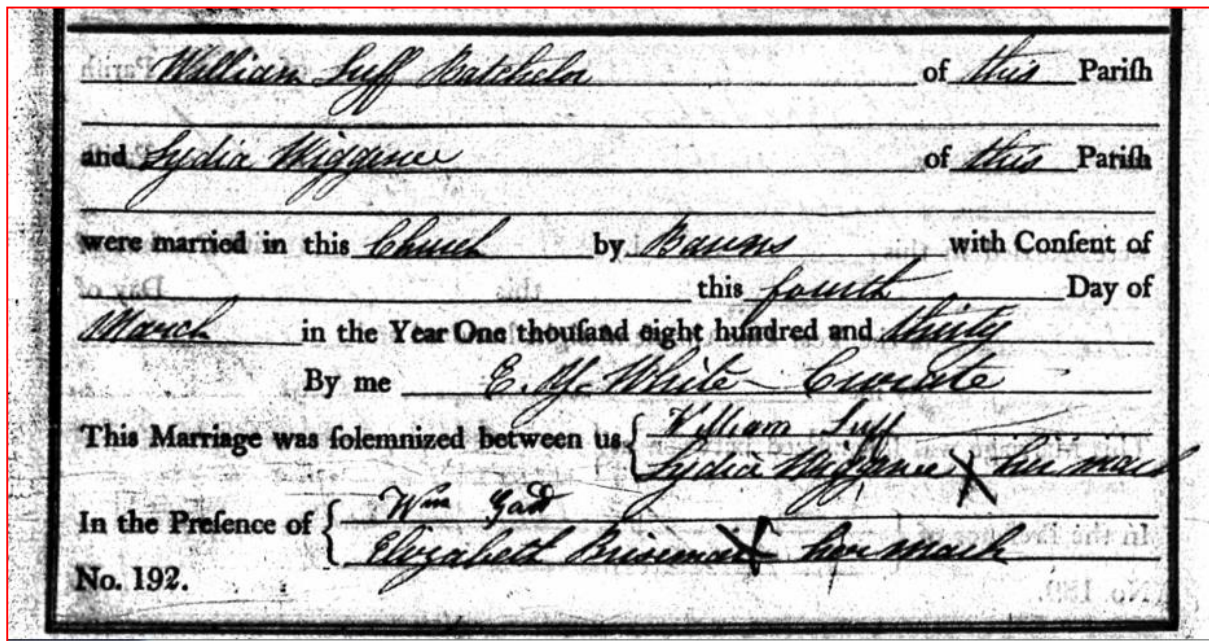


William Luff was baptised at St Andrew's Church, Farnham, on 27<sup>th</sup> January 1809. He was the son of William and Jane Luff.

William Luff married Lydia Wiggence at Crondall Church on 4<sup>th</sup> March, 1830.



William Luff died in Hale on 9<sup>th</sup> April, 1841. He was 32 years of age. His death certificate states he died from a brain fever. His mother, Jane Luff, was present at his death at Hungry Hill, Hale. (Source Official Death Certificate)

I have found a marriage certificate which suggests that Lydia Luff, widow, married Charles Nicholas, a widower, at Yateley in Hampshire on 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 1844. It seems the couple were living in Hartley (now Hartley Witney) at the time of their marriage. This could be Lydia Luff the widow of William Luff. (Source Official Marriage Certificate)
