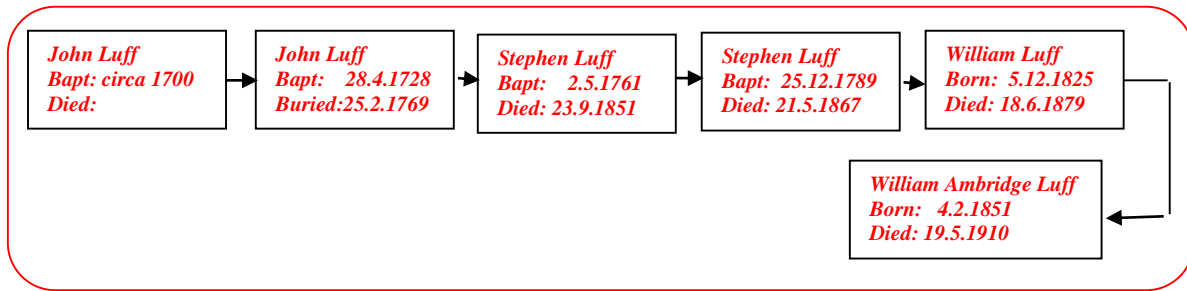


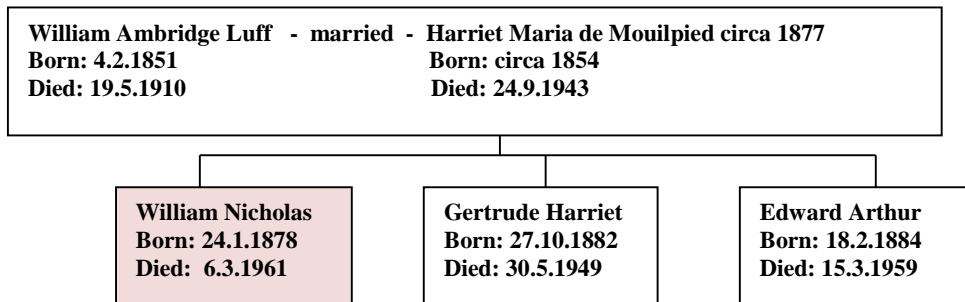
William Nicholas Luff 1878 - 1961

The 1911 census shows William Nicholas and Edith living at 3, Vauvert Terrace, Guernsey. William Nicholas was a salesman in a furnishing company. They had no children at this time. William Nicholas with his brother Edward Arthur ran the family furnishing business.
