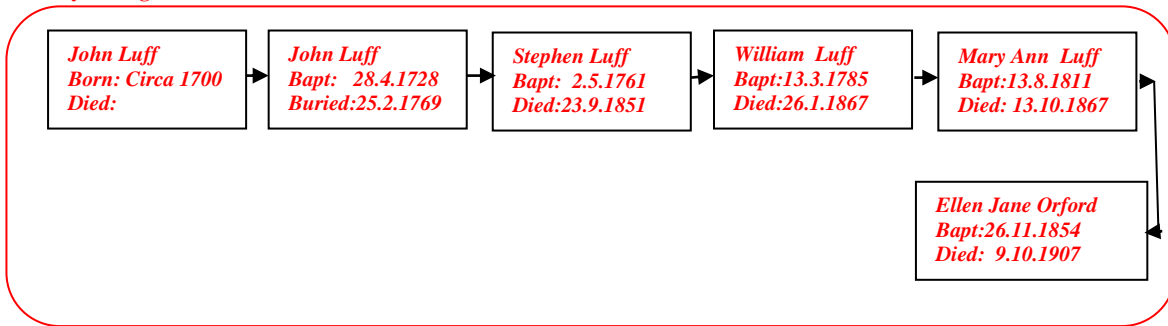

Annie Lilian Ford was baptised in Farnham on 5th July, 1894. She is the daughter of Ellen and Walter Ford.

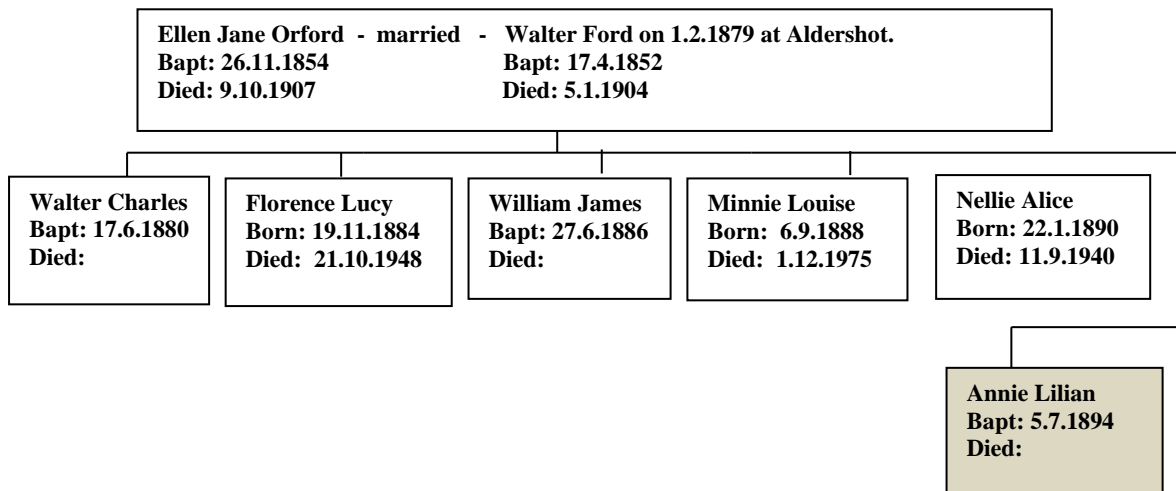
