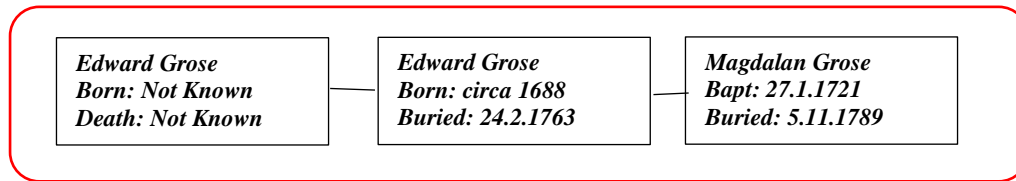


## James Newton 1750 - 1820

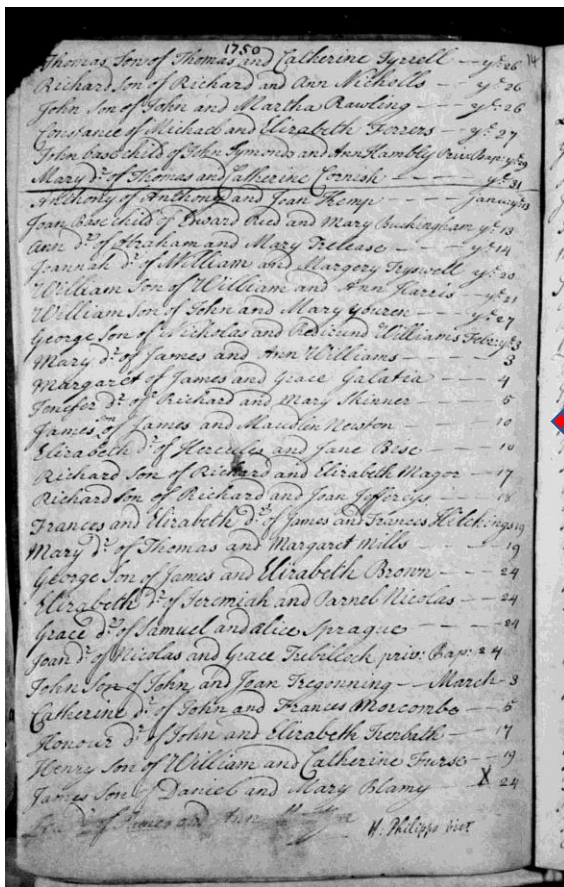

### Family Lineage:

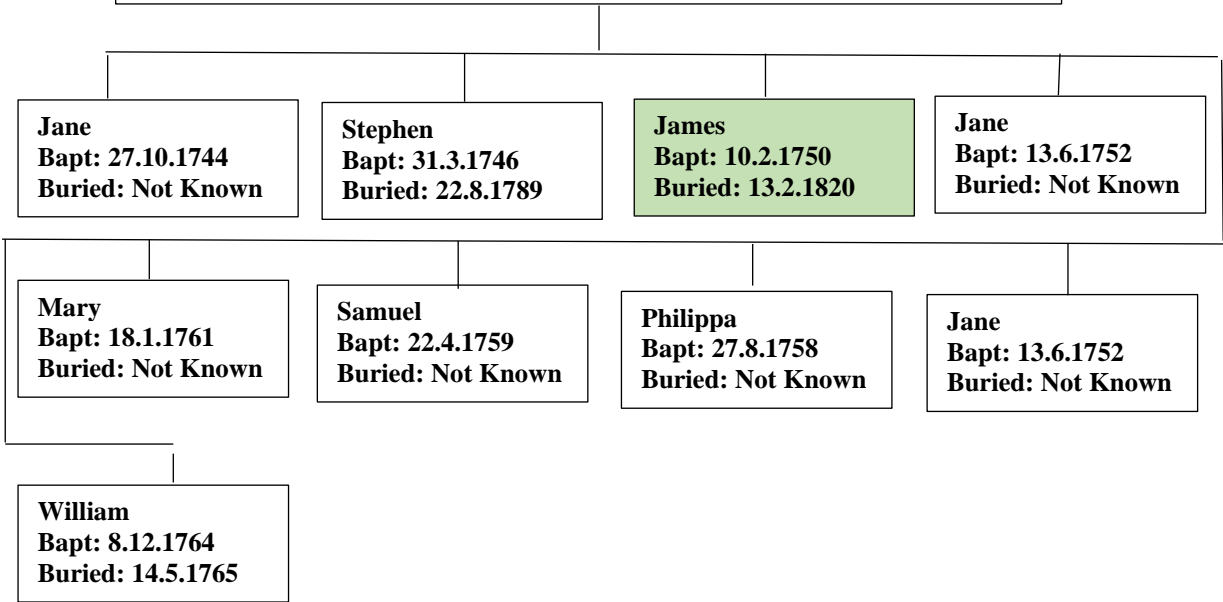


James Newton was baptized on 10<sup>th</sup> February, 1750 at Gwennap, Cornwall. He is the son of Magdalan Grose and James Newton.
