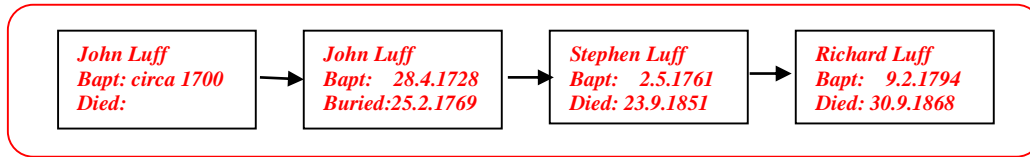


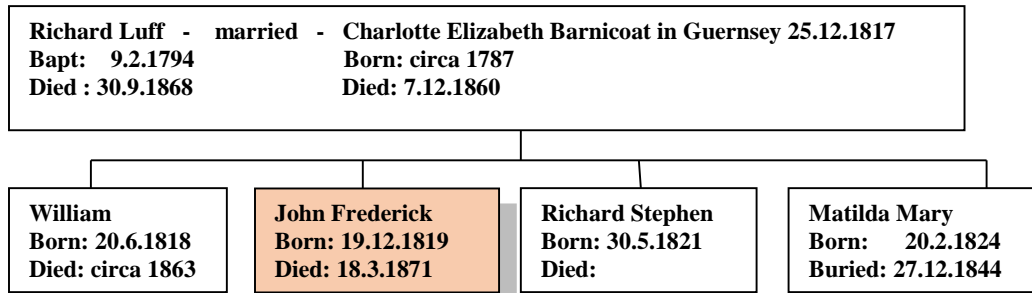
John Frederick Luff 1819 - 1871

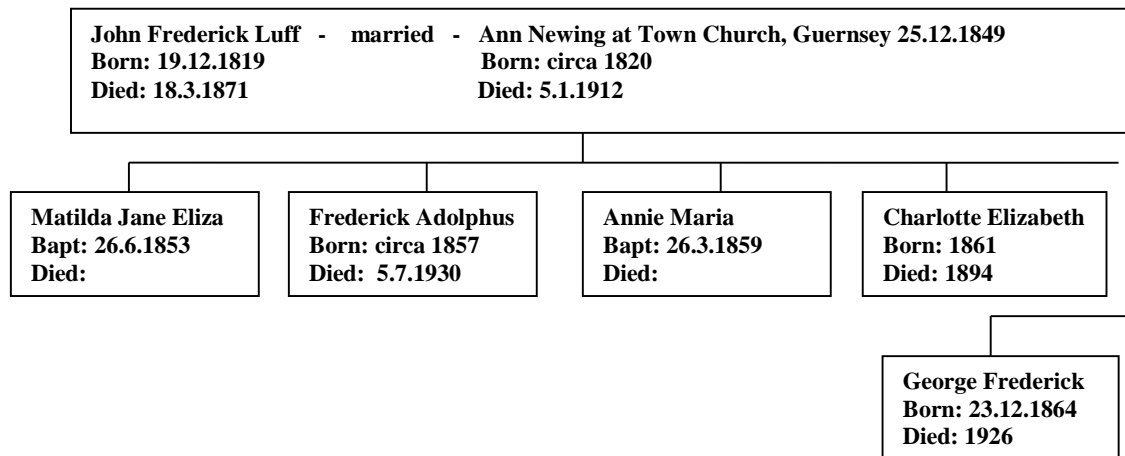
Family Lineage:
