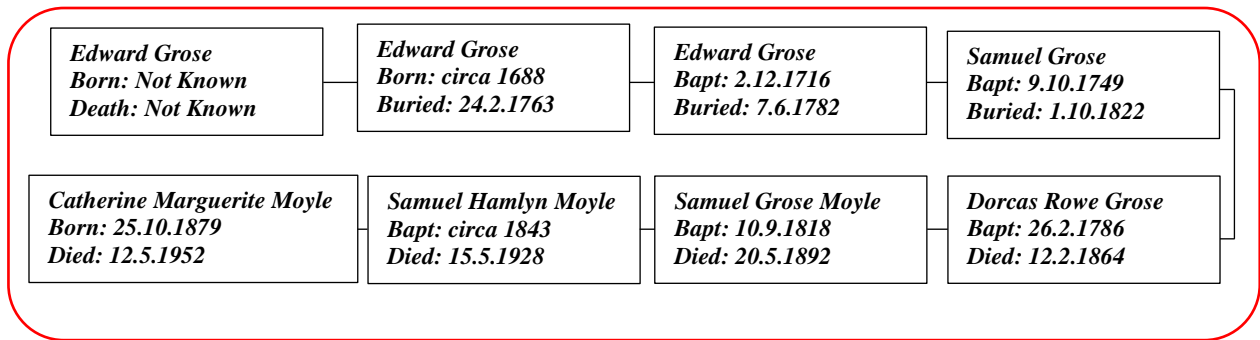


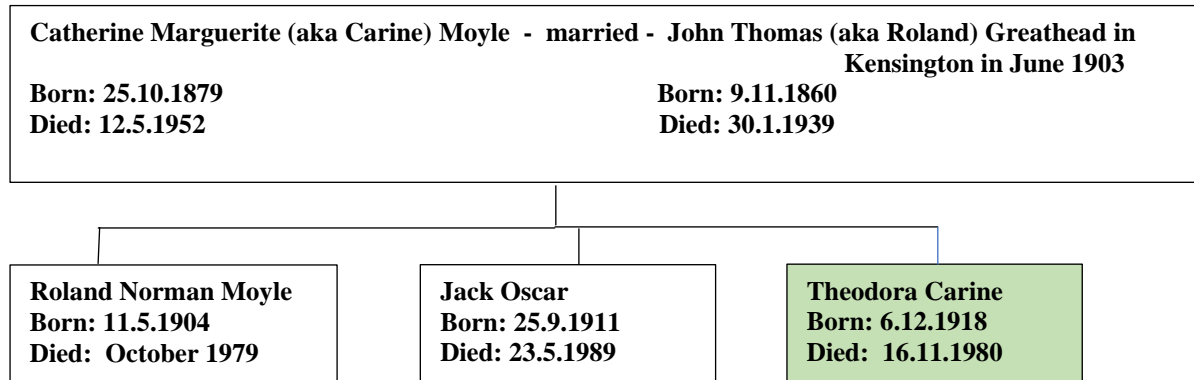

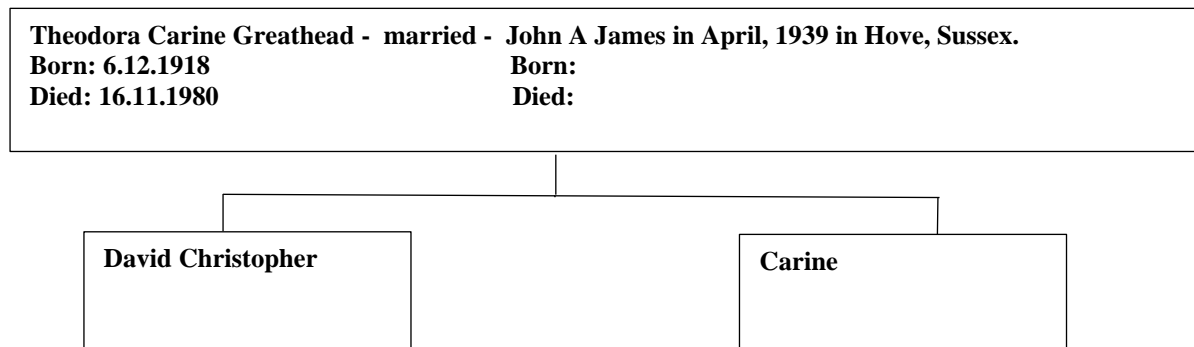
Family Lineage:
