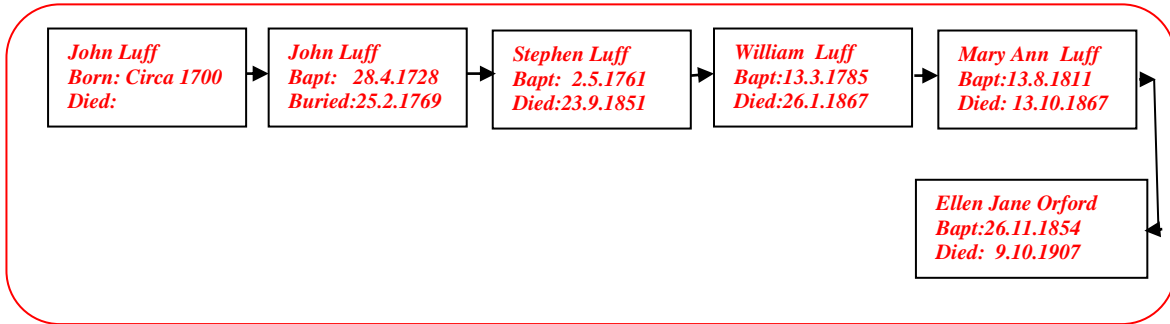

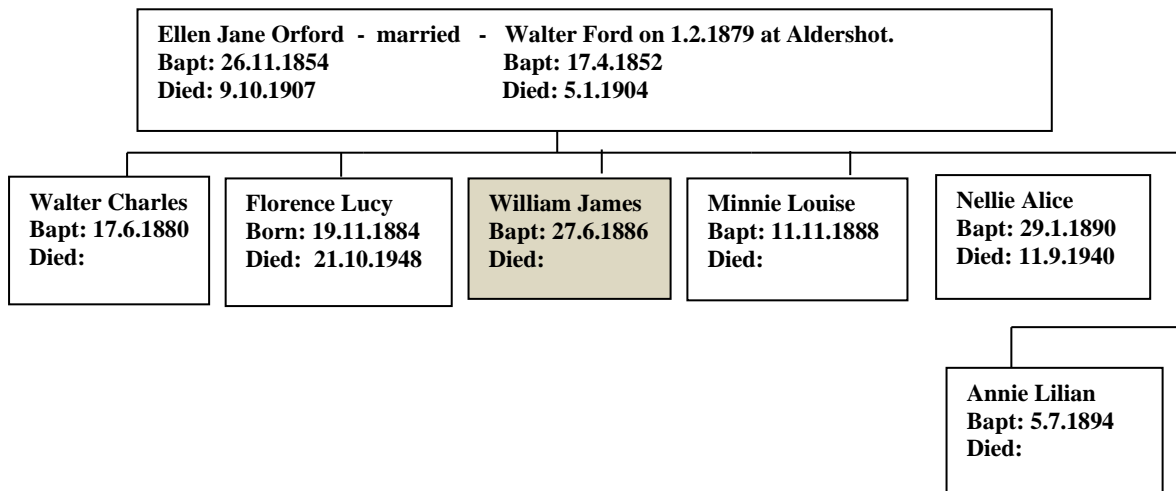


William Ford was baptised in Farnham on 27th June, 1886. He is the son of Ellen and Walter Ford.
